General Points:

The issue of uniform standards for the STP's outlet and disposal on land for gardening/irrigation purposes was discussed at length in the CAC meeting dated 01.02.2014 and subsequently has finalized in CAC meeting dated 15.04.2014 as to prescribe the domestic effluent standards BOD-30 mg/lit, SS-50 Mg/lit & COD-100 mg/lit. Recently, Committee noted that the CPCB has published the revised standards for STP outlet as BOD- 10 mg/lit & SS- 10 mg/lit.

In view of above, it was decided to impose the standards for STP outlet as BOD-10 mg/lit & SS-10 mg/lit to all the STP of infrastructure projects by granting 04 to 06 months' time to implement the same. Henceforth, all the consents shall be issued by stipulating the above standards for STP outlet along with time limit for implementation.
