Minutes of 2nd sitting of 9th Consent Appraisal Committee Meeting of 2013-2014 held on 05.08.2013 at 11.00 am at Conference Hall, MPC Board, Kalpataru Point, 4th Floor, Sion Circle, Sion (E), Mumbai 22.

The Secretary, Home (Transport) Dept., Mantralaya, Mumbai, Member and could not attend the meeting. Leave of absence was granted to him.

Chairman of the committee welcomed the members of the committee and allowed proceeding of the meeting to start. The minutes of the 1st sitting of the remaining agenda items of 5th Consent Appraisal Committee Meeting and agenda items of 9th Consent Appraisal Committee (CAC) meeting of 2013-2014 held on 29.08.2013 circulated under Board's letter No. MPCB/CAC cell/minutes/B-3430 dated 31.07.2013 were confirmed.

The meeting thereafter deliberated on the agenda items placed before the committee and following decisions were taken.

Resubmission Items

They submitted the letter dated 02/08/2013 from Co-Gen unit supplier M/s. Triveni Turbines, Shivajinagar, Pune certifying that they are supplying 14.75 MW turbine generator set to the said industry. Further the industry submitted the re-designed details of ETP units. It was decided to grant consent to Establish for Sugar (4500 TCD) & Co-Gen (14.75 MW). It was also noted that the proposed ETP units of aeration tank & secondary clarifier seems to be oversized. It was decided that double amount of BG as per the matrix for achieving the standards to be obtained while granting C to 1 st Operate, in case, the ETP units are not right sized.

The consents shall be disposed after obtaining requisite consent fees as per GoM, revised fee structure dtd. 25.08.2011 and according to the new industry wise validity period. The balance fees on the part of MPCB, if any, shall be considered at the time of next renewal of consent, which shall be mentioned in the consents to be issued hereafter.

General Points:

Action Point-I	<p>1. The remaining agenda of 5th CAC meeting of Sugar units was discussed in detail with respect to sectoral approach. It was observed that the information of sugar units who have applied for renewal was available. It was decided that all the sugar units under the purview of CAC will be discussed in CAC next meeting. CAC cell to prepare format of 4 specific issues of sugar units i.e.,</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Is the effluent generation 100 Ltrs of per Ton cane crushing (Y/N), ETP Units provided along with sizes & Adequacy,Whether Covered the Effluent Carrying Pipeline to Avoid ingress of Bagasse (Y/N),Adequate Land available for the Disposal (20 CMD for 1 Acres) (Y/N) &Whether APC Systems like ESP/Bag Filters/Wet Scrubber is provided (Y/N) of individual sugar units. <p>It was decided to collect the above information of remaining sugar industries under the purview of CAC from RO/SRO by 08/08/2013 by TA. The TA shall forward the collected and compiled data to JD (WPC) on above points. JD (WPC) should prepare a sectoral report on following points.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Benchmark for sugar industries, in respect of complianceStrategies to bring down pollution level in sugar industries.Suggest measures to be included in all consent letters by way of directions/BG. The compiled data of all sugar units along with the report of JD(WPC) shall be submitted before CAC in its next meeting scheduled on 16/08/2013.Monitoring/Surveillance systems with calendar to be implemented by RO's/SRO's. <p>2. CAC noted that representative of industries under the purview of CAC are called for personal hearings by HOD. It was decided that such cases should be submitted before MS/Chairman for approval and the industry representative to be called for hearing before CAC. Sr. Law Officer to issue circular in this regard.</p> <p>3. The consent application submitted to SRO without requisite consent fees should henceforth not be kept pending at any level for want of fees. The said application should be submitted before CAC for suitable decision. TA to issue circular in this regard.</p> <p>4. CAC noted that the application of some of the industries is submitted without CC/CAC tag. Chairman instructed TA & AST take necessary steps to sort out the issue.</p>
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
