5. Earlier consent was refused by Board on 05/04/2011 due to non compliance of proposed directions issued earlier & CREP Guidelines.
6. Closure notice was issued by RO Aurangabad as due to discharge of spent wash on land for gardening, the seepages, run off entered into nearby nalla which ultimately meets to Terna .
7. Personal hearing was extended on 23.12.2011 & restart directions were issued.

- Industrial effluent generated from Existing distillery 400 CMD & from Expansion 296 CMD will be evaporated in MEE. After evaporation it will become 188 CMD which will be stored & used for Bio composting on existing Compost Yard.
- Composting will be carried out on 7 acres of Land which is HDPE lined and impervious as per CREP Norms.
- Industry has complied CREP guideline.
- As per environmental Clearance industry was supposed to provide ESP to Boiler.
- Reply to SCN is received.
- We may not grant Consent.

HOD Remarks:-

1. Applied for Consent to establish (Expansion).
2. Application received at SRO Nagpur-II on 01/10/2011 and at HQ 05/11/2011.
3. Textile industry involving Twisting, drawing and thermoset processing.
4. Existing industry is having full fledged ETP and JVS results are within prescribed limits.
5. Land available for disposal of effluent is 130 Acres.
6. Bag house provided as an Air Pollution Control equipment and mechanical dust collector as stand by arrangement.
7. The site of proposed expansion is @500 meters from river Kanhan.
8. The application was discussed in CAC dtd 07/12/2011 & SCN for refusal of consent was issued as industry is not satisfying RRZ policy.
9. Ind replied that ind is in existence since 1986 i.e prior to RRZ policy.
10. Ind requested for grant of Consent as no IE is generated.
11. Industry has submitted own assessment report on no increase in pollution load.
12. We may accept the proposal & grant Consent to Establish though industry falls in RRZ restricted area.

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for grant of **Renewal of consent** for hotel activity Swimming Pool & Laundry activity (209 Rooms) for built-up area is 12809.43 sq. m.
2. Application received at RO on 02.09.2011 and at HQ on 02.01.2012.
3. Previous consent was valid upto 31.08.2011.
4. The sewage effluent generated is 286 CMD, which is treated in their STP (capacity-300 CMD) which comprises bar screen, ET, aeration tank, clarifier, filter press, ACF, PSF & SDB and the treated effluent is reused for flushing & gardening purpose. SRO has not submitted the JVS analysis results.
5. The bio-degradable waste generated is treated in organic converter and used as manure for gardening.
6. SRO reported that applicant have provided oil catchers to kitchen exhaust.
7. Also, reported that **C.I. increased from Rs. 122 Crs. to Rs. 203 Crs.** and accordingly, consent fees for consent to establish & 1st operate needs to recover from applicant. Applicant have not paid adequate consent fees presently.
8. RO-Pune issued SCN to the applicant on 26.12.2011 for not submitting CA-certificate, not paying fees, details of ETP/STP, Env. Stmt., Cess returns/payment details, etc.
9. RO recommended the case for grant of consent after satisfactory reply to SCN issued above. Applicant have not submitted the reply till date.
10. The case was **discussed during CAC meeting held on 31.01.2012** and it was decided to issue SCN for refusal of consent as applicant have not replied to the SCN issued by RO on 26.12.2011 and not paid the consent fees. SCN for refusal of consent is issued on 06/02/2012. Applicant have not replied the same till date.
11. Refusal of consent may be issued as applicant have not replied to the SCN issued.

CAC Item No. 09

Name of the Industry: **M/s. Ascent Hotels Pvt. Ltd.,**
32/1A&B, Weikfield IT Park,
Wadgaonsheri, Tal. Haveli, Pune.

HOD Remarks:

1. Applied for grant of consent for **hotel activity** for 5-star hotel having swimming pool & Laundry activity for built-up area is 27,403.21 sq.m. and total plot area of 15,224 sq.m.
2. Application received at SRO on 03.03.2011 and at HQ on 02.01.2012.
3. The consent to Establish was granted on 02.06.2006 for hotel with the condition of obtaining Env. Clearance, as per EIA Notification, 2006 and the applicant have obtained Environment Clearance for the same on 23.01.2007.
4. The sewage effluent generated is 189 CMD, which will be treated in their STP and trade effluent 7.40 CMD will be treated by primary followed by tertiary treatment and further it is mixed in STP. The treated effluent is reused/recycled for flushing & gardening purpose. The area available for disposal of treated effluent is 15,224 sq.m. i.e. 3.76 acres.
5. Industry has provided ozonation treatment for swimming pool.
6. The bio-degradable waste generated will be treated by composting.
7. SRO had issued letter to industry on 18.03.2011 & 20.04.2011 for non-compliances and RO has issued SCN for operating hotel without consent & without provision of ETP. Industry has replied the SCN and RO reported that they have provided necessary pollution control system. Further, RO has called explanation from SRO-Pune-I for forwarding application to RO after 9 months period.
8. **CA-certificate dtd. 05.01.2011 shows that C.I. is Rs. 264.47 Crs. and accordingly paid the fees. However, CA-certificate dtd. 05.01.2010 shows that C.I. is Rs. 387.19 Crs.**
9. The case was referred to CAO on 04/01/2012 for guidance on which CA-Certificate is correct. checking the CA Certificate and he has recommended that now C.I. of industry is increased compare to the consent to Establish, hence, called previous C.I. details of industry. Letter issued to the industry on 17.01.2012, reply received which is not satisfactory.
10. The case was **discussed during CAC meeting held on 23.01.2012** and during the meeting, it was decided to issue SCN for refusal of consent as industry has not submitted the required information and instead submitted three different CA-Certificates.

SCN for refusal of consent was issued on 06.02.2012. The applicant have not replied the same, till date.

11. Refusal of consent may be issued as applicant have not replied to the SCN issued.

CAC Item No. 10

Name of Industry: **M/s. Gharda Chemicals Ltd.**

HOD Remarks :-

1. Application for Amendment in Consent for Change in Product mix.
2. Products- Pesticides (Technical & Formulation).
3. Application received at SRO on 30/12/2011 and at HQ on 31/01/2012.
4. IE generation as per existing consent is – 525 m³/d Industry has provided Primary, Secondary & Tertiary treatment for effluent. Treated effluent is discharged to CETP Dombivli. Due to proposed change in product mix there will be no generation of additional industrial effluent.
5. Capital Investment of existing unit is Rs. 131.84 Crore. Capital investment for change in product mix is Nil.
6. Industry is already covered in CAC list at sr. no. 133.
7. The earlier consent of dtd. 2/07/2010 has also been granted with change in product mix. RO/SRO has recommended the case subject to EC/verification of Pollution load certificate. Repot submitted by RO/SRO do not mention compliance of consent conditions particularly air quality (source/ ambient) . SRO has forwarded compliance of directions issued by RO earlier. How ever it seems only the industries report is forwarded. Dombivali MIDC is CEPI area hence the application of such major unit should have been processed more carefully. The alternate product ABPBI is proposed 9.0 MT/M or the existing product CHBP / PEK – 26MT/M. How ever, there is net increase of 93 MT/M of BY- products considering the overall increase in production these will attract para (b) of MOEF Circular dtd. 14/12/2006.
8. It is proposed that C to E may be granted for new product mix subject to EC as recommended by RO, Kaylan with following conditions : –
 - RO shall review compliance particularly air emission s in one month.
 - The incinerable HW is sent to their Lote plant. It is necessary to consider that incinerator as common facility for compliance purpose.
 - Continuous stack and ambient air monitoring to be provided with in four months, for which industry shall submit B.G. Of RS. 5.0 Lakhs.
 - The JVS are exceeding some times, B.G. of Rs. 5.0 Lakhs be taken for ensuring compliance.

2. Earlier consent was valid up to 31/12/2011. incl. efflt.6312 CMD from process and sea cooling water 72410 CMD Disposal- partly reused & partly discharged in to Mahul creek.
3. Generation of domestic effluent is 600 CMD, STP provided.
4. Industry has provided primary, secondary & tertiary treatment followed by reverse osmosis. disposal in to Mahul creek. HW. Disposal by CHWTSDF. Haz. Waste disposed through CHWTSDF. APC provided.
5. Industry has submitted environment statement for the year 2010-2011 and cess returns up to 30/06/2011.and cess paid upto 30.06.2011.
6. Industry has submitted requisite consent fess for the period up to 31/12/2013 i.e. for two years.
 - several significant non- compliances have been observed by RO (M) Including discharge of untreated effluent & catalyst in the drain.
 - RO (M) has already issued SCN for these non- compliances. Industry has replied, but the reply do not clarify the reason of such non-compliances and just mention the SOP's ,but not @ implementation.
 - During parliament committee meeting dtd 21.01.012, both HPCL/BPCL CMD's mentioned that the entire effluent including cooling water is recycled and only make up water is lifted from creek which was not in factual. The effluent is discharged in to creek.
7. Considering the overall compliance level, the decision of SCN for refusal of consent with respect to non compliances of VOC standards and online monitoring was taken during the CAC meeting dtd.31.01.012 and as per decision SCN was issued on 06.02.012.
8. Vide industry's letter dtd 13.02.012 stated that the industry has provided treatment facility followed by reverse osmosis wherein 68% of the incoming treated water recycled back & the balance 32% comprises rejects stream which meets the norms. Purge treatment unit outlet treated stream routed to the circulating salt cooling water system of the refinery & is not discharged to Mahul creek.

9. However, the industry has not accepted or commented on the non-compliances reported in SCN. They have just referred to the normal practice being followed which is as per design criteria. During the meeting with GM (Tech) at HQ, the observations made were accepted by him. He was asked to further explain the non-compliances observed & the remedial measures including senior level reviews of compliance. He has assured on senior level reviews and monitoring on regular basis. The refinery has taken several envit. Initiative and considering the commitment of senior level review, the renewal may be considered with following.
10. Renewal only for one year.
11. Refinery to submit action plan for improvement, duly signed by occupier Director (ops), within 3 months.
12. BG of Rs. 5.0/- Lakhs each towards effluent, air and HW issues referred in notice.
13. Review by team of MPCB officers for the compliance in May 2012.
14. Consent may be renewed for the period up to 31.12. 2012.

 - i) The production capacity will be increased by increasing PPC ratio from present 70 percent to 100 percent PPC along with increasing fly ash addition unit.
 - ii) Industry will not propose to increase clinker production.
 - iii) Fly ash consumption will be increased from 1900 TPD to approx 3800 TPD.
 - iv) No increase in fuel or clinker capacity. There will be increase in cement grinding activity only.

Recommended for Consent to Establish for expansion in cement plant for cement production 3.9 MTPA to 4.48 MTPA.

3. Capital Investment of the Industry increased from Rs.167.10 to Rs.172.92 Cores. Industry has submitted consent fee of Rs.40,97,520/- for the period up to 31.3.2015.
4. Domestic Effluent is 24 CMD. Septic Tank provided. Industrial Effluent is 4125 CMD including mine discharge. Mine water is used for spraying of water on roads and balance water is discharged into nearby nalla after treatment in sedimentation tank. ETP is provided for workshop effluent.
5. Analysis results of ambient air quality monitoring carried out between 21.1.2011 to 23.06.2011, shows parameter RSPM & SPM are exceeding the standards hence mine authority needs to improve the O & M of existing pollution control system.

Recommended to issue show cause notice for refusal of consent due to non-compliance of consent conditions and exceeding ambient air quality monitoring results.
