## **Resubmitted Agenda**

### **CAC Item No.01**

**Name of the Industry: Hindalco Industries Limited (Expansion Project),  
Sr. No. 95/1, 95/2, Village Daheli, Tal Mouda, Dist Nagpur**

#### **H.O.D. Remarks:**

1. Existing RED/LSI unit of manufacturing of Aluminium strips & sheets – 3250 MT/Month having valid consent for the period up to 31.12.2012.
2. Now applied consent to establish for expansion for manufacturing of additional products of Aluminium Strips, Sheets, Foils and Aluminium Laminated and Printed Products -2250 Mt/month.
3. Capital investment of the proposed expansion is Rs.197.34 crore. Capital Investment of the existing unit is Rs.198.8/-crore. ( Total C.I. is Rs. 396.14/-crore)
4. Industry has paid consent to Establish fee of Rs. 3,94,780/- as per New Consent Fee GR dated 25.8.2011.
5. Industry does not satisfy RRZ policy as Kanhan River is about 350 meter from plant, hence industry required to submit the pollution load certificate for existing and expansion activity.

The case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 16.04.2012 & it was decided to issue SCN for refusal of consent for not complying with RRZ policy, 2009. Accordingly, SCN dated 24.04.2012 was issued to the industry. Industry vide e-mail dated 25.05.2012 submitted the reply to the SCN.

In view of non-compliance of R.R.Z. Policy we may refuse the application of the industry for expansion project.

Discussed in CAC Meeting held on 3.7.2012 and it was decided that SLO shall review the industry reply dated 25.5.2012 regarding coverage of Kanhan river policy 2009 and resubmit the case in next CAC. SLO recommended that the file may be referred to RRZ policy Committee for review and opinion.

The industry vide letter dated 14.09.2012 has submitted the revised proposal for the expansion project for further consideration. Industry stated that there will not be any increase in production level. Only they are proposed to add some machineries like rolling mill/separator/roll grinder/annealing furnace etc. so that from the same machine micro level alluminium sheets can be made keeping the same production level and there will be reduction in water quality to 60 me3/day and no increase in effluent quantity discharge.

The additional machine cost 197.34 Crores to install the same. The unit has given original and modified proposal.

Discussed in CAC dated 24.09.2012 and it was decided to review the assessment of pollution load proforma submitted by Industry thorough IIT, Mumbai regarding Certification on "No increase in pollution load" due to expansion.

The communication received from the unit on 29.11.2012 submitted that IIT Mumbai does not validate the pollution load increase and will take much time. The unit has requested for grant of consent to Establish based on commitment given by the industry and ready to undertake / implement any additional condition imposed by MPCB prior to commission of new equipment on the basis of IIT Mumbai at latter stage.

The case was again discussed in CAC dated 24.12.2012 and decided to keep the case in abeyance till self assessment report of industry for no increase in pollution load is received.

The unit has submitted self assessment report in appropriate format vide letter dated 18.01.2013. The comments of R.O. /SRO yet not received.

## **CAC Item No.02**

**Name of industry : - Sudarshan Chemicals Industries Ltd.,  
44, 45, 46 MIDC Dhatav, Roha, Raigad.**

### **HOD Remark**

- Application recd at RO Raigad on 12.03.2012
- Application recd at HQ on 23.05.2012
- Mfg of pigments, pesticides & intermediates.
- Applied for Consent to Establish for expansion of pigments in existing plot No.46. Product attracts EC. Industry has acquired plot No 44.,45 but as per MIDC letter these plots shall be used only storage of raw material and finished products as a godown activity.
- Existing plot No 46 is 800 mtr and plot no 44 & 45 are 750 mtr away from Kudalika river. Plot no 44 & 45 are exactly 750 mtr & attract RRZ policy 2009.
- Proposed along with existing industrial effluent will be disposed of into CETP but CETP capacity is not adequate.
- Existing I.E. – 5688 CMD, D.E. – 170 CMD. Proposed IE- 7246 CMD, DE-52 CMD. ETP consist primary, secondary and tertiary treatment. Disposal– CETP.
- JVS reports are some time exceeding the limit. For proposed expansion no ETP proposal.
- The case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 25/07/2012 and it was decided to keep the case in abeyance till compliance of Hon'ble High Court order in respect of CETP.
- Now the present status called from SRO Raigad II and SLO's comments regarding the CETP performance.
- SLO stated that, "CETP Roha has taken effective steps to improve the O & M, including upgradation of CETP by collecting initial contribution from its members and the proposal of DPR is under NEERI appraisal. The CETP has taken a no. of steps including provision of 10 surface aerators installation of belt press for dewatering of sludge, replacement of pipelines etc".
- SLO further opined that, the consent may be consider for C to E by imposing condition that C to O shall be consider after NOC from CETP.
- The case was again discussed in CAC held on 31.01.2013 and it was decided to keep the case in abeyance till the decision of the committee constituted wrt Mandhana Industries Ltd, Tarapur decision would be take in light of the same. Revert back CAC in March 2013. Mean while industry representation has received vide letter dtd 15/02/13. industry has requested to grant C to E with a condition that, C to O would be granted after CETP expansion and its readiness to accept effluent.
- RO Raigad has remarked that, consent to establish may be considered as per policy of the Board.

As per SLO's remark, we may consider the case for grant of C to E by imposing condition for C to O would be granted after obtaining EC and the CETP expansion and NOC from CETP for readiness to accept effluent by imposing BG conditions.

**HOD Remark:**

1. Applied for First Consent to Operate for 270 MW Coal based Thermal Power Plant.
2. The unit has obtained Environment Clearance vide letter dated 15.05.2009 by Environment Department, Govt. of Maharashtra.
3. The case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 27.12.2012 and it was decided to issue show cause notice for refusal towards non-compliance of consent conditions and EC conditions. Accordingly SCN issued to industry vide letter dated 7.1.2013. Industry vide letter dated 16.1.2013 submitted the reply of SCN. Also SRO, Nagpur-II vide letter dated 19.01.2013 submitted the point wise reply of SCN.

The work of S.T.P. /Internal Roads/CAAQMS not yet completed. In view of above we may keep the consent in abeyance till the completion of above work and point wise compliance of Consent to Establish/Environment Clearance from RO/SRO.

### **H.O.D. Remarks.**

- 1) Applied for 1<sup>st</sup> **Consent to Operate for Phase-I ( 1 x 300 MW) & Phase-II (1 x 300 MW)**
- 2) The case was discussed in CAC held on 20.03.2012 and it was decided to keep the case in abeyance till completion of work and compliance of consent / EC conditions. Again it was discussed in CAC dated 26.11.2012 and decided to keep the case in abeyance till completion of pollution control works.
- 3) SRO Nagpur has submitted the present status report vide letter dated 17.01.2013. The work of railway siding will be completed by March, 2013 till that time unit will utilize truck transport. CAAQMS installed. STP installed.

The unit has made representation that the railway siding and dedicated line within the plant wagon tippler is expected to be commissioned /inspection from railway authorities by May, 2013, till that time they may be allow to transport the coal from Butibori upto Plant site.

In view of above, we may grant consent to operate to the unit for 1 year period subject to condition that

- i) The unit shall made operational the railway siding with all inspection formalities on or before 31.05.2013. The B.G. of Rs.10/- Lakhs shall be submitted.
- ii) They shall ensure the adequate care shall be taken while transportation of coal by road from Butibori Railway siding upto plant coal stock yard, so that no spillage/overloading all along the roads shall be observed. All the coal /mineral transportation trucks shall be completely covered with tarpaulin covers. The operational B.G. of Rs.10/- lakhs shall be submitted.
- iii) For O & M of pollution control system B.G. of Rs.10/- shall be submitted.

4. Industry has submitted reply on 30.03.2012.
5. Industry has paid consent fees Rs.6,19,207/- + Rs.1,00,000/-as per revised G.R.25.08.2011.
6. RO- Raigad has recommended case for grant of consent to operate after clarification about Environmental Clearance.
7. This case was discussed second time in CAC meeting held on 03.07.2012 and it was decided to issue SCN for refusal of consent to 1<sup>st</sup> operate as EC has not yet been obtained.
8. Industry has obtained copy of clarification letter dated 04.07.2012 from Env. Dept, GOM stating that the proposed unit does not attract provisions of EIA Notification 2006 .But if the total BUA of the proposed unit is 20,000 sq.m. or more required EC under schedule 8 of EIA Notification 2006.
9. This case was again discussed in CAC meeting held on 21.08.2012.Letter was send to Environment Department on 07.11.2011 to get the clarification regarding applicability of EC. Letter of Environment Department dated 01.02.2013 received to the Board stating that in this case EC is applicable.
10. Industry has not submitted copy of EC in the Board, Hence Case may be kept in abeyance till the submission of EC.

1. Applied for 1<sup>st</sup> Consent to Operate for 1 x 500 MW Coal based Thermal Power Station- Stage-I,
2. Industry has obtained Consent to Establish for Electricity generation of 1000 MW Stage-I project through coal based Super Thermal Power Station vide letter dated 29.04.2008.
3. Capital investment of the industry is Rs.4,827.46Crores. Consent fee of Rs.96,55,020/- is paid by the industry for the one year period .
  
4. The industry has already obtained Environment Clearance from MoEF, GOI vide letter dated 25.01.2008.

In view of commitment given by the company to made operational the railway siding within next 3 months. **We may grant consent to operate for 1 year period with condition that;**

- i) They shall commission the railway siding to transport the coal by railway up to factory coal stock yard on or before 15.05.2013 with B.G. of Rs.10/- Lakhs.
- ii) They shall ensure the adequate care while transportation of coal by road from Kamptee coal mines, so that no spillages/overloading all among along the roald transportation shall be observed. The operational B.G. of Rs.5/- Lakhs may be taken.
- iii) The S.T.P. shall made commissioned on/or before 31.03.2014 with B.G. of Rs.5/- Lakhs.
- iv) For O & M of pollution control system B.G. of Rs.10/- Lakhs.

3. We may consider grant of consent to operate with condition that the industry shall commission STP before 31/01/2014 with BG of Rs.5/-akhs and operational BG of Rs.5/- Lakhs
4. We may place the case before CAC for further discussion.

2. Application grant of renewal of Consent to operate with amalgamation received at H.Q. on 20.12.2012.
3. Paid Consent fee of Rs.11, 07,720/-.
4. Water Cess paid up to July, 2012.
5. Environment Statement for the year 2011-2012 submitted.
6. SRO/RO Nashik recommended for grant of Consent to Operate with amalgamation up to 31.12.2014.
7. This case was discussed in the CAC held on 08.012.013.It was decided to grant plain renewal of consent to operate by extending BG of RS.5 Lakhs towards o & M of pollution control system and keep 1<sup>st</sup> consent to operate in abeyance and resubmit the case with clarification regarding capacity expansion.
8. Industry has extended BG up 31.12.2014.and submitted reply that due to fluctuation in market demand of capacitors they are changing process flows as per requirement types of capacitors. Due to this water /air pollution remains unchanged.SRO Nashik has informed that industry has undertaken excess production than consented qty.
9. Recommended for grant of Consent to Operate for additional qty with amalgamation up to 31.12.2014 And
  - 1] Industry shall submit the Board resolution as they have done excess qty without consent to operate /establish.2] Forfeit the BG of Rs.5 Lakhs as they have done excess production without intimation to Board.3] Obtain the additional BG of Rs.10 Lakhs towards operational and maintenance of pollution control system.

**Name of Industry: - EMCO Energy Ltd., (Phase-I), (1 X 300 MW Phase I, Coal Bases TPS), MIDC Warora, Dist - Chandrapur**

#### **H.O.D. Remarks:**

1. Applied for grant of consent to operate for phase -1 for power generation of 1x 300 MW.
2. The industry has obtained consent to establish for phase -1 for 1 x 300 MW from the Board vide letter dated 23/06/2010.
3. The Industry has obtained Environmental clearance from the MoEF, GOI, vide letter dated 19th May 2008 (2x135mw) & amendment vide letter dated 4th June 2009 for 1 x330 MW project.
4. Gross capital investment of the industry is Rs 1627.74 Crores. Industry has paid consent fee of Rs 32,55,480/- for one year, as per new GR.
5. Domestic Effluent is 384 CMD. Industrial Effluent is 6218 CMD. STP & ETP provided. Treated Effluent will be recycled in the process.

Earlier the case was discussed in CAC dated 3.7.2012 and it was decided to keep the case in abeyance till the completion of pollution control system as per E.C. / Consent Condition. Board has called report from R.O. Chandrapur vide letter dated 13.7.2012. R.O.Chandrapur vide letter dated 18.09.2012 has submitted present status report of the industry stating that boiler and APCS i.e. ESP and Chimney works has been completed and other auxiliary work i.e. CHP, ash bund, ETP & STP are found in progress and expected to complete all environmental works by the End of Sept. 2012.

Again the case was discussed in CAC dated 24.09.2012 and it was decided that HOD to verify the compliance of consent to establish condition and E.C. conditions. R.O. Chandrapur has submitted the present status report of compliance vide letter dated 14.02.2013 and stated that work of ash dyke is in progress. CAAQMS not yet installed.

As per the report received from unit on 20.02.2013 stating that they have completed ash dyke pond for first unit, STP is completed, CEMS is installed. CAAQMS is yet not installed.

We may grant consent to operate for the period up to 31.12.2013 with condition that the unit shall install CAAQMS within next 4 months with B.G. of Rs.5/- Lakhs and also operational O & M B.G. of Rs. 5/- Lakhs.

- e. SRO Jalgaon has requested that ordinance factory is discharging treated trade/sewage effluent in to irrigation canal since inception.
- f. Industry has paid water cess up to 30.09.2011.
- g. SRO- Jalgaon has recommended grant of amendment in consent to operate.
- h. This case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 27.12.2013 and it was decided not to amend consent.
- i. RO Nashik has submitted letter dated 06.02.2013 stating that industry has stopped discharge of treated effluent as per CAC decision. - SRO, Pune – I has issued warning notices to the Industry vide letter dt.14.05.2012 and 25.07.2012 for exceeding JVS.
- Compliance submitted by industry to the query letter dt. 12.11.2012 of SRO is as follows.
- At earlier applied for 24 MW Co-gen and got the EC from GoM for 24 MW. But instead of 24 MW , installed 21 MW unit. For this industry has submitted the supporting documents a) Sugar Commissioner Sanction letter. B) Mahavitaran Superintendent Engg. Letter. C) Board of Directors resolution.
- Spent Oil – 400 Lit./M is mixed with Bagasse and used as fuel in boiler.
- ETP operation is started 1 month before the crushing season to achieve the MLSS.
- Reduced the effluent quantity to 100 ltrs per Tone cane crushed from last crushing season.
- 80% work of provision of 15 Days storage tank is completed.
- Separate ESP is provided to 40 TPH and 80 TPH Boiler.
- Cess paid upto Jan 2012 and returns are submitted upto Sep 2012.
- Upgraded ETP in last season 2011-2012.
- ESP is provided to the Boilers.
- Earlier BG expired no renewal obtained for earlier BG.
- We may grant renewal with BG of Rs. 5.0 Lakhs and Rs. 2.0 Lakhs.

2. Product- Hydrogen Peroxide (100% w/w basis) & Hydrogen Gas.
3. Application received at SRO on 15/03/2011 and at HQ on 21/07/2011.
4. The case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 20.03.2012 and also industry had given presentation before CAC and it was decided to keep the case in abeyance till industry obtaining locational clearance for expansion activity. Accordingly the decision of CAC was communicated to the industry vide letter dtd. 07.04.2012.
5. Production quantities as below:
