**Name of the Industry: M/s Hindalco Industries Limited, (Expansion Project),  
Sr. No. 95/1, 95/2, Village Daheli, Tq. Mouda, Dist. Nagpur**

#### **HOD Remarks:**

1. Existing RED/LSI unit of manufacturing of Aluminium strips & sheets – 3250 MT/Month having valid consent for the period up to 31.12.2012.
2. Now applied consent to establish for expansion for manufacturing of additional products of Aluminium Strips, Sheets, Foils and Aluminium Laminated and Printed Products -2250 Mt/month.
3. Capital investment of the proposed expansion is Rs.197.34 crore. Capital Investment of the existing unit is Rs.198.8/-crore. ( Total C.I. is Rs. 396.14/-crore)
4. Industry has paid consent to Establish fee of Rs. 3,94,780/- as per New Consent Fee GR dated 25.8.2011.
5. Industry does not satisfy RRZ policy as Kanhan River is about 350 meter from plant, hence industry required to submit the pollution load certificate for existing and expansion activity.

The case was discussed in CAC meeting held on 16.04.2012 & it was decided to issue SCN for refusal of consent for not complying with RRZ policy, 2009. Accordingly, SCN dated 24.04.2012 was issued to the industry. Industry vide e-mail dated 25.05.2012 submitted the reply to the SCN.

In view of non-compliance of R.R.Z. Policy we may refuse the application of the industry for expansion project.

Discussed in CAC Meeting held on 3.7.2012 and it was decided that SLO shall review the industry reply dated 25.5.2012 regarding coverage of Kanhan river policy 2009 and resubmit the case in next CAC. SLO recommended that the file may be referred to RRZ policy Committee for review and opinion.

The industry vide letter dated 14.09.2012 has submitted the revised proposal for the expansion project for further consideration. Industry stated that there will not be any increase in production level. Only they are proposed to add some machineries like rolling mill/separator/roll grinder/annealing furnace etc. so that from the same machine micro level aluminium sheets can be made keeping the same production level and there will be reduction in water quality to 60 me3/day and no increase in effluent quantity discharge.

The additional machine cost 197.34 Crores to install the same. The unit has given original and modified proposal.

Discussed in CAC dated 24.09.2012 and it was decided to review the assessment of pollution load proforma submitted by Industry thorough IIT, Mumbai regarding Certification on "No increase in pollution load" due to expansion.

The communication received from the unit on 29.11.2012 submitted that IIT Mumbai does not validate the pollution load increase and will take much time. The unit has requested for grant of consent of Establish based on commitment given by the industry and ready to undertake / implement any additional condition imposed by MPCB prior to commission of new equipment on the basis of IIT Mumbai at latter stage.

The matter is placed in CAC for further decision.

- The case was discussed in CAC meeting dated 3.7.2012 and it was decided to resubmit the case in CAC after obtaining verification report from RO regarding differences in the SRO & industry reporting in respect of C.I.
- RO vide E-mail dated 12.12.2012 submitted the verification report. RO has reported that
  - Industry has submitted the C.A. certificate. The gross block submitted by hotel had not gone for any expansion.
  - There is no physical expansion in hotel rooms, plant and machinery and same fact is certified by CA certificate stating that Gross Block of fixed assets without depreciation is Rs. 315.46 Crs.
  - Hotel occupier has reported that controversial information given by them regarding C.I. was due to lack of knowledge to concerned persons from their management.
  - Block of Rs. 143.73 Crs deployed towards procurement pf land, Rs. 72.99 crores towards project feasibility & sundry expenses for second phase of project.
  - The second phase of project will be dealt separately in respect of consent from Board & Environmental Clearance.
- JVS results dated 27.6.2012, 28.9.2012 and 22.10.2012 are within consented limit. JVS results dated 17.7.2012 are exceeding the consented standard.
- SRO has reported that the Hotel authority complied the Interim Directions issued on 27.1.2012.
- RO has recommended for grant of renewal of consent upto 31.1.2015
- Recommended for grant of renewal.

- Application received at SRO on 28.6.2012 and at HQ it received on 30.7.2012.
- Previous consent was valid up to 30.6.2012 for Hotel activity – 299 Rooms
- SRO reported that existing STP is adequate for treatment of additional sewage generated, and the treated domestic effluent is being used for flushing & gardening. The excess effluent will be discharged in to MCGM sewer. Hotel authority has provided ozonization for swimming pool of water.
- SRO has recommended to grant of renewal of consent to operate with enhanced capacity.
- As the industry has carried out expansion of hotel without obtaining prior permission from the Board, SCN may be issued for violation of the consent conditions.
- The case was discussed in CAC Meeting Dtd.26.09.2012 & it was decided to issue SCN for refusal of consent for carrying out expansion of hotel authority without obtaining. SCN was issued on 10.10.2012. Hotel authority submitted their reply dtd.22.10.2012.stating that they have not constructed additional floor more than as stipulated in EC and EC was granted for basement + Gr+ upper 9 floors. However even today building is constructed Basement + Ground + service floor including part mezzanine floor + upper typical 8 floors. It is further clarified that at the time of obtaining EC and consent to establish from the board, they had internal architectural design for 299 Rooms for hotel. Enhanced 43 rooms are accommodated by modification in plans as modified approved plan from Municipal Corporation dtd.11.06.2011. Also mentioned that EC was granted for total plot area of 17441.30 sq. mtr. and total BUA of 33784.59 Sq. Mtr. thereafter as per municipal corporation requirement plot area of 6500.00Sq. Mtr. was separated for hotel building with total BUA 17036.71 Sq. mtr. and remaining plot area and BUA was kept for commercial building.
- From report of SRO Mumbai II (received on 21.11.2012) correspondence made by Regional officer Mumbai it has been observed that the hotel authority has applied for C to E prior to enhancement of 43 rooms. SRO Mumbai II further reported that the existing STP provided is adequate for taking additional sewage treatment.
