Minutes of 8th Consent Appraisal Committee Meeting of 2013-2014 held on 16.7.2013 at 11.00 am at Conference Hall, MPC Board, Kalpataru Point, 4th Floor, Sion Circle, Sion (E), Mumbai 22.

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The Consent Appraisal Committee meeting of the Board was held on 12.7.2013. Following members of the Consent Appraisal Committee were present:

The Secretary, Home (Transport) Dept., Mantralaya, Mumbai, Member and Shri.P.P.Nandusekar, Technical Advisor(Env), MIDC, Mumbai, Member could not attend the meeting. Leave of absence was granted to him.

Chairman of the committee welcomed the members of the committee and allowed proceeding of the meeting to start. The minutes of the 7th Consent Appraisal Committee (CAC) meeting of 2013-2014 held on 12.07.2013 circulated under Board's letter No. MPCB/CAC cell/minutes/B-3177 dated 16.07.2013 were confirmed.

The meeting thereafter deliberated on the agenda items placed before the committee and following decisions were taken.

4. Emphasis shall be given towards provision of primary treatment (with disinfection) to the infectious liquid waste generated from the HCEs before sending it to STPs for further treatment and its disposal.
5. All Government Hospitals shall be considered for exemption of consent fees on similar lines to that of Authorization fees as per GoM GR 10.04.2003.
6. It was decided that Combined authorization & consent shall be issued to HCEs. Also the Delegation of powers for granting BMW authorization & Consent to HCEs shall be as below:

There are some cases pending with HQ & SRO/RO. The cases at RO/SRO shall be called within 7 days at HQ by special messenger to CAC cell in revised format only & the cases at HQ will be processed and submitted to CAC cell within 7 days.3. Format of Board Resolution submitted by Sr. Law Officer was discussed during the meeting and Sr. Law Officer was informed to modify the draft incorporating the following points:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Resolution should already indicate the Board of Company is aware of violation of environmental laws.• The Board of Company should assure that in future there will be no such violation.• The Board of Company should state whether previously such resolution was passed in the past where they have assured that there will not be further violation of Environmental Laws.4.
