As per the RRZ policy 2009 Govt. of Maharashtra classification of River A-II class is upto Chawane Weir only. Further SRO has also reported that, based on the submission made by the MIDC before Hon'ble NGT, the order dtd 28.11.2013 in which it is stated that the location of industry does not fall under RRZ policy. While going through the affidavit made by the MIDC, MIDC has submitted in the affidavit that "it appears that the RRZ ends at Chawne Weir & the site allotted to the Respondent No. 1 is further downstream of the Chwane Weir."</p> <p>The Hon'ble NGT has passed Judgment vide order dtd 28.11.2013 in para 15 which is as under.</p> <p>"Respondent No. 1 has also submitted that as per the RRZ Notification 2009, the Patalganga River basin, beyond the Chawne Wier, is classified as SWZ (Saline Water Zone) by the Govt. of Maharashtra & therefore, the restrictions envisaged in the RRZ, where river stretches have been classified as A-I, A-2, A-3, A-4 are not applicable to the present location of the industry. MIDC has also submitted that as far as Patalganga river is concerned, the RRZ outer limit as per plan of Govt., of</p> | | |

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| | | | | <p>Maharashtra ends at Chwane Weir & the site allotted to Respondent No 1. is further downstream of the Chawane Weir. We do not find any substantial reason to disregard the submissions made by MIDC regarding location of the industry & therefore, the claim of the Applicant that the location of the industry is against the RRZ Notification is unacceptable & will have to be rejected.</p> <p>It was also noted that the industry has obtained CRZ clearance vide dtd 06.03.2014 for effluent disposal in the saline water zone.</p> <p>It was decided to grant amendment in C to E by adding Captive Power Plant 16 MW in the existing C to E with overriding effect to earlier consent to Establish upto COU or Five years from revised C to E granted vide dtd 24.07.2012 whichever is earlier.</p> <p>Consent DFA placed in the agenda is approved by replacing condition no. 9. with the condition that PP shall submit the affidavit in Board's prescribed format within 15 days regarding the compliance of conditions of EC & CRZ clearance granted vide no. J-11011/202/2011 – 1All (I) dtd. 30.01.2013 & CRZ-2012/CR-121/TC-2 dtd. 10th January 2013 respectively and C to E.</p> | | |

Industry shall submit BG of Rs. 25,000/- to provide flow meter and pH meter at the outlet of treated effluent plant. 3. Industry shall submit BG of Rs. | | |

Industry shall submit BG of Rs. 1.0 Lakh towards mode of disposal (CHWT/SDF, Recycle, incineration etc.) 6. Industry shall submit BG of Rs. 25,000/- towards Maintaining Records. 7. Industry shall submit BG of Rs. 10 lakh towards Operation & Maintenance of the Effluent Treatment Plant to achieve disposal standards. 8.
