Note: As decision taken in CAC meeting held on 03.11.2015, regarding granting consent for maximum validity i.e. 5 years for Red category, Orange - 6 years Hence all above industry consent to renewal shall be granted for 5 years after obtaining requisite consent fee, excluding Sugar industries.

As per the circular issued by the Board vide no.MPCB/AS(T)/TB/B-5087 dated 03.12.2015.

1] All consent shall be issued by prescribing condition of new hazardous waste rule dated 04.04.2016 for compliance of Hazardous Waste and other wastes (Management & Transboundary Movement), Rules 2016.

2] As per new BMW rule PSO to submit the compliance report for all the HCE for STP / ETP.

The agenda item placed before the Committee for the policy of sugar industries regarding grant of Renewal of Consent to Operate was discussed in detailed and following decisions are taken –

- If industry is fully complied with the CREP norms, installed online monitoring system and maximum JVS reports are within Consented limit then Consent shall be granted. If JVS reports are exceeding the consented limit then, Consent may be granted by forfeiting appropriate BG as per the percentage of exceeding JVS results.
- If industry is fully complied with CREP norms but not installed online monitoring system then SCN for Refusal of Renewal of Consent shall be issued.
- If industry is fully complied with the CREP norms and installed online monitoring but having various other non-compliances such as excess crushing, discharge of effluent outside, JVS reports are highly exceeding the limit then SCN for Refusal of Renewal of Consent shall be issued.
- In the case of excess crushing (more than 5000 TCD) then the case shall be referred to Environment Dept. / MoEF for EC violation. Similarly if the industry carried out excess crushing but below 5000 TCD then Consent shall be issued by forfeiture of BG and obtaining /imposing condition of BR for excess crushing & top-up BG for not to do excess crushing. Also issue directions regarding excess crushing.

• CC has authorized Hon'ble Member Secretary to take decision regarding grant of Renewal of Consent to Operate for pending Consent applications at SRO level and also issue Show Cause Notices to the sugar industries who have not applied for grant of Renewal of Consent to Operate.
