Permission for direct disposal of treated effluent of M/s Sudarshan Chemical Industries, Roha into MIDC disposal pipeline.			<p>Personal hearing regarding the permission for direct disposal of treated trade effluent at outlet of CETP was extended to the industry before JD(WPC) &amp; AS(T) on 20.02.2016.</p> <p>After detailed discussions and MIDC's No Objection letter and on the basis of the recommendation of Committee, it was decided to give No Objection for the disposal of the treated trade effluent of M/s Sudarshan Chemical Industries Ltd, for existing unit to dispose off their treated effluent at the outlet of CETP through dedicated effluent disposal pipeline provided by MIDC subject to following terms and conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Industry shall ensure the ETP operations so as to meet the Environment (Protection ) ACT, 1986 standards of 30 mg/l BOD concentration at the outlet.</li> <li>2. Industry shall provide online monitoring system to monitor the parameters such as pH, BOD, &amp; COD at final outlet of ETP and at the disposal point at CETP outlet</li> <li>3. The MIDC shall ensure the disposal of treated effluent as per the location suggested by NIO.</li> <li>4. At present, the consented standards of BOD is 100 mg/l, hence needs to be amended accordingly for BOD 30 mg/l considering disposal in the Creek.</li> <li>5. Industry shall obtain the permission from MIDC.</li> </ol>
