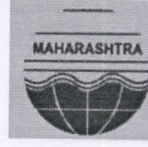

Sub: Guidelines for collection, transportation and disposal of Covid-19 waste and solid waste from quarantine centres, containment areas and home quarantined patient.

Sir,

As per the Biomedical Waste Management Rule, 2016 and amendment thereof, the biomedical waste generated from the Health care Establishments (HCEs) shall be collected and disposed off in accordance with the procedure specified, through MPCB authorized CBWTFs. Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has issued specific guidelines to handle biomedical waste generated during the treatment of Covid-19. Latest version-4 is published on 21.07.2020 (Copy enclosed).

The MPCB has authorized total 30 Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility (BMW CTFs) across the State to cater all the healthcare establishment operating in the state.

:2:

Due to the prevailing COVID-19 2<sup>nd</sup> surge in the state it is essential to ensure COVID-19 waste is managed strictly in accordance with CPCB guidelines. The State Govt. is identifying the Covid-19 infected suspected person in home isolation and declaring larger areas as containment zone.

Therefore, it is requested to instruct Chairman / Secretary, Housing Societies / Apartment owner Associations in your jurisdiction that, CPCB guidelines shall be strictly followed for safe management of Municipal Solid Waste and Biomedical Waste from the home quarantine / containment areas and COVID-19 HCEs and ensure safety of public and frontline workers involved in waste management.

Look forward for your earlier consideration and necessary action.
