Sub - Difficulties faced by your office in implementation of
Of the Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling)
Rules 1998

With reference to your letter dtd.6/8/2010 on the captioned subject, followed by the communication from Shri Ranjeet Sangle, Advocate, Mumbai and personal hearing extended to him alongwith the Incharge Zonal Officer and you, it is to inform you that though, the draft Action Plan on Bio-Medical Waste Management prepared during the interaction meet held on 8/8/2008 at New Delhi was circulated by the Sr.Environment Engineer and Incharge of Hazardous Waste Management Division, Central Pollution Control Board vide letter dtd.8/9/2008, wherein, it has been mentioned that Amendments required in the BMW Rules, more particularly "Deep Burial to be banned at CBMWTSDFs, the said draft Action Plan has not yet finalized and no such amendment as such has been issued by the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Govt. of India till date.

During the course of personal hearing extended to him on 27/07/2010, it has been specifically noted that as far as the BMW Rules, 1998 are concerned, as per Schedule-I at the Note it is mentioned that "Deep Burial shall be an option available only in towns with population less than 5 Lakhs and in rural areas". It has also been observed that no amendment has been made in respect of the provision of deep burial facility in the above area and the draft Action Plan circulated by the Hazardous Waste Management Division of the Central Pollution Control Board has not so far been finalized.

In view of the above circumstances, the clarification has been issued that in the township and rural areas, having population less than 5 lakhs, the scientific deep burial is a permissible activity and therefore, the condition in respect of incineration may not be considered in case of such type of facilities, unless it is economically and otherwise feasible.

Regarding obtaining of the membership of particular Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facility by the Doctors and other Bio-Medical Waste generating Institutions, the area allocation has not so far done by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and therefore, it will be inappropriate to insist particular Doctor or Institution generating bio-medical waste to join particular facility.

The Environment Department, Govt of Maharashtra had issued Resolution dated 30th Dec 2006 for effective implementation of Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 1998. The said committee was in existence for a period of two years and the shall hold two meetings in a year. The said committee had been expired in the year 2008. Therefore the Board has requested to the Environment Department, Govt of Maharashtra to reconstitute the said Advisory Committee for effective implementation of Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 1998 vide letter dated 20th Sept 2010. A copy of the said letter is enclosed for your ready reference.

It has been decided to hoist the status of Authorization granted by the Board to 100 bedded and above Health Care Establishments / hospitals on the Website of the Board. A copy of the same is enclosed for your information.


The Board had issued Directions under section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 read with Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 1998 to M/s Mtrityunjai Ashram (CBMWTSDf), vide letter dated 30/5/2009. If the said Common Bio-Medical Wastes Treatment and Disposal facility has taken corrective measures, then a fresh proposal for grant of authorization and operating the scientific deep burial system, the application can be sent to the Zonal Officer (PAMS Division) for further approval.

Whenever incinerators are being operated in order to know the compliance of emission standards of such incinerators, periodical monitoring is to be carried out by way of spore test etc.

During the course of hearing, it was brought to the notice that on many occasions the Municipal Councils/ Corporations has not made available the land for disposal of Bio-Medical Wastes. Therefore you are directed to make communication with the Phalton Municipal Council/Corporation to make available the land for Common Bio-Medical Wastes Treatment and Disposal Facility.

However only for the establishment of construction of Nursing Home/ Hospitals/ Clinics, NOC of the Board is not being insisted. The NOC is insisted before grant of permission to operate such hospitals/ Nursing Home/Clinics/Laboratory generating Bio-Medical Wastes, so as to ensure the compliance of Bio-Medical Wastes Rules 1998.

This is issued with the approval of the Member Secretary of the Board.

उपरोक्त विषयास अनुसरून या कार्यालयास आपले पत्र प्राप्त झाले असून आपण जैव वैद्यकीय कचरा (विल्हेवाट व हाताळणी) नियम, १९९८ च्या अंतर्गत विविध मुद्द्यांबाबत मार्गदर्शन व माहिती मागविली आहे. सदर माहिती खालीलप्रमाणे:

१. जिल्हानिहाय सामूहिक जैव वैद्यकीय कचरा विल्हेवाट केंद्राना म. प्र. नि. मंडळातर्फे प्राधिकार पत्र प्रदान करण्यात येते. त्यांची यादी सोबत जोडली आहे. ही यादी नियमाप्रमाणे अद्ययावत करून मंडळाच्या संकेतस्थळावर उपलब्ध करण्यात येते.
२. सामूहिक जैव वैद्यकीय कचरा विल्हेवाट केंद्राकडून आकारण्यात येणाऱ्या शुल्काची प्राप्त माहिती सोबत जोडली आहे. परंतु याबाबतची खातरजमा संबंधित केंद्राकडून करून घ्यावी.
३. जैव वैद्यकीय कचरा (व्यवस्थापन व हाताळणी) १९९८, अन्वये ज्या शहरांची लोकसंख्या ५ लाखापेक्षा कमी आहे, अशा ठिकाणी असलेल्या वैद्यकीय आस्थापनांना भूभराव (deep burial) करण्याची मुभा देण्यात आलेली आहे. असे भूभराव पीट बांधताना त्याचे बांधकाम व त्यामध्ये जैव वैद्यकीय कचऱ्याची विल्हेवाट नियमाप्रमाणे शास्त्रोक्त पध्दतीने करणे गरजेचे आहे. परंतु ज्या वैद्यकीय आस्थापनांना अशा प्रकारची व्यवस्था स्वतः उभारून ती योग्य त्या शास्त्रीय पध्दतीने नियमित स्वरूपात चालविणे शक्य होत नाही, अशा आस्थापनांनी सामूहिक केंद्रांना संलग्न होणे आवश्यक आहे.

सदर पत्र विधी विभागाच्या सहमतीने निर्गमित करण्यात येत आहे.




The Board had received representation from Harmony Trust regarding implementation of Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 1998. The Personal hearing was extended by the Board on 27th July 2010 before the Member Secretary of the Board wherein, the representative had invited the to the notice that under Rule 9 of the Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 1998, stating that there is provision for Constitution of Advisory Committee comprising of Experts in the Field of Medical , Health, Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Sciences, Environmental Management, Municipal Administration, and any other related department or organization including non – government organizations. The State Pollution Control Board may represent the said committee as and when required and advice the committee State Govt, Union Territory as well as prescribed Authority about the matters related to the implementation of these Rules.

The Environment Department has issued Government Resolution dated 30th Dec 2006 for effective implementation of Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 1998. The said committee was in existence for a period of two years and the meeting may be held two times in a year. The said Committee period has been expired in the years 2008.

It is therefore necessary to reconstitute the said Advisory Committee for effective implementation of Bio-Medical Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules 1998 and to keep the Meeting two times in a year alongwith the All India Doctors Associations (Representative) and NGO to discuss and redress the practical difficulties face by the Health Care Institutions. On the last occasion, the Bio-Medical Wastes PIL NO 41 of 2006 and 32 of 2006 was come up on 16th June 2010, wherein the Hon'ble High Court has directed to take action against

the defaulting Health Care Establishments including issuance of Closure Directions. A copy of Hon'ble High Court Order dated 16th June 2010 is enclosed alongwith the Government Resolution dated 30th Dec 2006 for ready reference.


Sub: Entry of Bio-Medical Waste Authorization Application in the Consent Module of the website.

Board has already issued directions for entry of all the consent / authorization applications in the consent module of the MPCB website. This is mainly to inform the people / entrepreneur about the status of their application.

Some NGO's have brought to the notice that the status of Bio-Medical Waste Authorization is not available on MPCB website. On review, it was noticed that the entries of BMW Authorization Applications are generally not taken in the consent CMS of MPCB website.

This was discussed at Head Quarter and it has been decided that all the Bio-Medical Waste Authorization received at all the RO/SRO office must be entered in the consent CMS of MPCB website and the authorization issued should have EIC Number similar to the practice followed in the consent applications.

This shall scrupulously follow with effect from 1st August, 2010.


Sub: Entry of Bio-Medical Waste Authorization Application in the Consent Module of the website.

Board has already issued directions for entry of all the consent / authorization applications in the consent module of the MPCB website. This is mainly to inform the people / entrepreneur about the status of their application.

Some NGO's have brought to the notice that the status of Bio-Medical Waste Authorization is not available on MPCB website. On review, it was noticed that the entries of BMW Authorization Applications are generally not taken in the consent CMS of MPCB website.

This was discussed at Head Quarter and it has been decided that all the Bio-Medical Waste Authorization received at all the RO/SRO office must be entered in the consent CMS of MPCB website and the authorization issued should have EIC Number similar to the practice followed in the consent applications.

This shall scrupulously follow with effect from 1st August, 2010.
