We do not find any substantial reason to disregard the submissions made by MIDC regarding location of the industry & therefore, the claim of the Applicant that the location of the industry is against the RRZ Notification is unacceptable & will have to be rejected. It was also noted that the industry has obtained CRZ clearance vide dtd 06.03.2014 for effluent disposal in the saline water zone. It was decided to grant amendment in C to E by adding Captive Power Plant 16 MW in the existing C to E with overriding effect to earlier consent to Establish upto COU or Five years from revised C to E granted vide dtd 24.07.2012 whichever is earlier. Consent DFA placed in the agenda is approved by replacing condition no. 9. with the condition that PP shall submit the affidavit in Board's prescribed format within 15 days regarding the compliance of conditions of EC & CRZ clearance granted vide no. J-11011/202/2011 – 1AII (I) dtd. 30.01.2013 & CRZ-2012/CR-121/TC-2 dtd.

Industry shall submit BG of Rs. 5 lakh towards Operation and Maintenance of Air Pollution Control Devices to achieve emission standards. 9. If Industry fails to submit above BGs by 03.06.2014, consent shall be treated as cancelled.	
Consent draft placed in the agenda is approved with above condition(s). Further it was decided to inform the industry that their request to review the decisions of encashment of BG was not approved.
