As per consent total effluent generation is 1421 CMD (877 CMD existing + 544 CMD expansion), however, their actual effluent generation is 1288 CMD (740 CMD existing + 548 CMD expansion), out of this 338 CMD is high COD, TDS bearing effluent &amp; 950 CMD is low COD, TDS bearing effluent. The treated effluent of high COD, TDS bearing, 200 CMD is recycled. At present only 7 products will be taken up for manufacturing on batch basis as per market demand, while calculating the effluent generation all 42 products are taken in consideration. v) PP has submitted the details of scrubbers provided to the hydroxyurea plant i.e. HCL scrubber. vi) PP has prepared the compatibility chart of all chemicals &amp; finished products, the copy of same is uploaded. vii) PP has submitted details of relocation of bagasse ash i.e. bagasse ash was temporarily stored which was sold to brick</p>
