PP also submitted water budget and stated that they will achieve ZLD as per EC condition. As per submission total effluent generation will 1430 CMD and will be used in cooling tower, spry pond, ash quenching, ash yard & for firefighting as per demand.
The physical verification of compliance of EC conditions will be carried out once the plant start its operations.

Committee also noted the industries difficulty about implementation of time targeted compliances / completion of work related to pollution control activities due to current Covid-19 Pandemic situations and restrictions thereof. The Committee decided to extend the time limit given for implementation of various time targeted compliances for next 4 months i.e. up to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021.
