
-: <u>JUDGEMENT</u>:-(Pronounced on 16th March, 2016)

1] Accused are facing trial for the offence punishable U/sec. 15 & 16 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

2] In brief, case of complainant in as follows:-

The complainant is Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, constituted under Section 4 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the said board is represented by Shri. N. G. Nihul, who is Regional Officer at Thane for the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and he is authorized Officer for the purpose of visit, inspection etc. Accused No. 1 is private company, who is represented by accused No. 2 in the capacity of Director. He is directly incharge of and responsible for the conduct of business of





- On behalf of company and himself, today accused No. 2 appeared before the Court. The charge (Exh. 11) has been framed against him, to which he pleaded guilty. Accordingly, his statement is recorded at Exh. 12. He submitted separate application in respect of plead guilty before the Court. Consequences of plead guilty was narrated to accused. However, the said accused remained firm on his decision to confess the guilt with prayer for minimum punishment.
- 4] Learned advocate for the complainant submitted that accused be punished with maximum fine. The learned



advocate for accused submitted that this is the first offence of accused No. 2 and he does not have any criminal antecedents.

His family members are totally depends upon him. Hence, prayed for leniency.

5] Considering the submissions of both the parties, following sentence will meet the ends of justice. Hence, I pass the following order.

: <u>ORDER</u> :-

- 1. Accused Nos. 1 and 2 are hereby convicted vide Section 246(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for the offence punishable under section 15 & 16 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for till rising of the Court and to pay fine of Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand Only) each, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for six month.
- 2. The copy of judgment be supplied to accused No.2 free of cost.
