- 1. The Consent to Establish is granted for a period up to: Commissioning of the unit or 5 year whichever is earlier

# 3. CONDITIONS UNDER WATER ACT:

(i) The daily quantity of trade effluent from the factory shall not exceed **360** M<sup>3</sup>. (Including existing Sugar Unit I.E. after expansion & modernization )

(ii) The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the factory shall not exceed 60 M<sup>3</sup>.
(Including existing Sugar Unit D.E. after expansion & modernization)

# (iii) (iii) Trade Effluent:

<u>Treatment</u>: The applicant shall provide comprehensive treatment system consisting of primary / secondary and/or tertiary treatment as is warranted with reference to influent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of the treated effluent to the following standards:

- (iv) Effluent Disposal: The treated effluent shall be used on land for gardening/irrigation within factory premises only. In no case, at any time effluent shall finds its way to any water body directly or indirectly.
- (v) Sewage Effluent Treatment: The applicant shall provide comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to influent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards.

(1)	Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	100	mg/l.
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- (2) BOD 3 days 270 C. Not to exceed 100 mg/l.
- (vi) Sewage Effluent Disposal: The treated effluent shall be recycled to the maximum extend and remaining shall be used on land for gardening.

(viii)Other Conditions: Industry should monitor effluent quality regularly.

# 4. CONDITIONS FOR MOLASSES STORAGE:

- (i) The molasses shall be properly collected and stored in steel tanks which shall be absolutely leak proof. At no stage of handling of molasses, there shall be leakage or spillage.
- (ii) The capacity of tanks for storage of molasses shall be such that at no time the molasses shall be required to be stored in kutcha pits. Adequate space storage capacity shall be available to take care of bumper production of sugar, non-lifting of molasses etc.
- (iii) All the area on which molasses are stored and handled should be provided with drain for diverting the spills to the treatment plant/ molasses tank. Suitable arrangements for accidental discharges of molasses from the tanks shall be provided to contain the same within factory premises.
- (iv) Destruction of molasses and its disposal shall not be done without specific permission in writing from the authorized officer of the Board, intimation of intention to destroy or dispose of the molasses shall be given to the Board atleast 15 (fifteen) days in advance by registered post under intimation to the Sub-Regional officer and Regional officer of the Board under whose jurisdiction the factory is situated.
- (v) The storage tanks shall be kept in good conditions all the year round with adequate maintenance. The tanks size and capacity per cm, height, total capacity in tonnes shall be displayed prominently near the tank.

- (vi) The above conditions shall be in addition to and not in derogation of the provisions contained in the "Bombay Molasses Rules, 1955" and "Maharashtra Molasses Storage and Supply Regulation, 1965".
- (vii)The industry should monitor effluent quality regularly.
- 5. The applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 (to be referred as Cess Act) and amendment Rules, 2003 there under
  - The daily water consumption for the following categories is as under:

The applicant shall regularly submit to the Board the returns of water consumption in the prescribed form and pay the Cess as specified under Section 3 of the said Act.

# 6. CONDITIONS UNDER AIR ACT:

(i) The applicant shall install a comprehensive control system consisting of control equipments as is warranted with reference to generation of emission and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the level of pollutants to the following standards:

# Control Equipment: —

#### a) Control Equipment:

ESP/Bag filter/Wet scrubber/Dust Collector of sufficient capacity provided to bagasse fired boiler shall be operated and maintained properly.

ESP/Bag filter/Wet scrubber/Dust Collector of sufficient capacity provided to sugar bagging section shall be operated and maintained properly.

#### b) Standards for Stack Emissions:

- (iv) The applicant shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. The chimney(s) vents attached to various sources of emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/ displayed to facilitate identification.
- (v) The industry shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises so as to maintain ambient air quality standard in respect of noise to less than 75 dB(A) during day time and 70 dB(A) during night time. Day time is reckoned in between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.

#### (vi) Other Conditions:

- 1) The industry should not cause any nuisance in surrounding area.
- 2) The industry should monitor stack emissions and ambient air quality regularly.

# 7. CREP conditions for Sugar Factory:

(A) Water Management:

- i. Operation of ETP shall be started at least one month before starting of cane crushing to achieve desired MLSS. So as to meet prescribed standards from day one the operation of mill.
- ii. Waste water generation shall be reduced to 100 litres per tone of cane crushed.
- iii. Industry shall achieve zero discharge into in land surface water bodies.
  - 15 days storage capacity tank shall be provided for treated effluent to take care of no demand for irrigation.
- (B) Emission Control: ESP/Bag filter/Venture scrubber shall be installed to comply with standards for particulate matter emission to < 150 mg/Nm3.

### 8. Conditions for D.G. Set

- a. Noise from the D.G. Set should be controlled by providing an acoustic enclosure or by treating the room acoustically.
- b. Industry should provide acoustic enclosure for control of noise. The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. A suitable exhaust muffler with insertion loss of 25 dB (A) shall also be provided. The measurement of insertion loss will be done at different points at 0.5 meters from acoustic enclosure/room and then average.
- c. The industry shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises in respect of noise to less than 55 dB(A) during day time and 45 dB(A) during the night time. Day time is reckoned between 6 a.m. to 10 p.m and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m to 6 a.m.
- d. Industry should make efforts to bring down noise level due to DG set, outside industrial premises, within ambient noise requirements by proper sitting and control measures.
- e. Installation of DG Set must be strictly in compliance with recommendations of DG Set manufacturer.
- f. A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use
- g. D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure
- h. The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.

# 9. CONDITIONS UNDER HAZARDOUS WASTE (MANAGEMENT, HANDLING & TRANSBOUNDRY MOVEMENT) RULES, 2008: (i)

The Industry shall handle hazardous wastes as specified below.

- The authorization is hereby granted to operate a facility for collection, storage, 1. transport & disposal of hazardous waste.
- The industry should comply with the Hazardous Waste (M&H) Rules, 2003. 2.
- 10. Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even, such emissions occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information should be forthwith Reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives, Inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the production process connected to it should be stopped.

### 11. Specific condition

- 1. Industry shall install new high pressure boiler of 100 TPH . One 25 TPH boiler from existing will be operated & one 25TPH boiler will be kept as standby. However Existing three boilers of two 16 TPH and one 22 TPH shall be scrapped.
- 2. Industry shall replace fibrizer 1 No., Mill drive 5 Nos steam will be replaced by electrical drives so that water consumption & waste water consumption will be reduced.
- 3. Industry shall reduced bearing cooling water at mill and open gear reduction gear by using centralized lubricating system resulting into reduction at waste water at Mills.
- 4. A separate tank shall be provided for collection of boiler blow down water & same water shall be use for wet scrubber.
- 5. Industry shall adopt evaporator station vapour bleeding system resulting in reduction in steam consumption as well as spray pond condensate water load.
- 6. Industry shall convert high head pan to low head pan which will helpful in reduction in steam/ vapour/condensate at spray.

7. Undustry shall replace existing batch type pans 3 Nos. each for B & C mascuite by continuous pan.

Industry shall replace existing 4 Nos. vaccum filters by 2 Nos. higher capacity vaccum filter resulting in reduction of water requirement for vaccum pump.

# **12. General Conditions:**

- The applicant should bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ (i) plantation. The applicant should submit a yearly statement by 30<sup>th</sup> September every year on available open plot area, no. of trees surviving as on 31st March of the year and no. of trees planted by September end.
- (ii) The applicant should provide for an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed by he applicant and operate the same in case of power failure to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the

absence of same, the applicant should stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms & conditions of this consent regarding pollution levels.

- (iii) The applicant should make an application for renewal of the consent at least 60 days before the date of the expiry of the consent. The applicant should not change or alter quantity, quality, the rate of discharge, temperature or the mode of the effluent/ emissions or hazardous wastes or control equipments provided for without previous written permission of the Board.
- (iv) The firm should submit MPCB, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992 before 30<sup>th</sup> September every year.
- (v) The applicant should install a separate meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment should be maintained. The applicant should also submit a comparative statement of designed power and chemical consumptions vis-a vis actual power and chemical consumption along with Environmental statement.
- (iv) Separate drainage system should be provided for collection of trade and sewage effluents. Terminal manholes should be provided at the end of collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No effluent should be admitted in the pipes/sewers down- stream of the terminal manholes. No effluent should find its way other than in designed and provided collection system. Neither storm water nor discharge from other premises should be allowed to mix with the effluents from the factory.
- (vii) The applicant should provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous wastes to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and should pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf. An inspection book should be opened and made available to the Board's officers during their visit to the applicant.
- (viii) The industry should ensure that fugitive emissions from the activity are controlled so as to maintain clean and safe environment in and around the factory premises.
- (ix) The applicant should maintain good housekeeping and take adequate measures for control of pollution from all sources so as not to cause nuisance to surrounding area / inhabitants.
- 13. This consent shall not be construed as any exemption from obtaining necessary No Objection Certificate from other Government agencies as may deemed fit necessary.
- 14. The applicant shall obtain Consent to Operate before Actual Commencement of the production
- 15. This consencto Establish is issued for expansion & modernization of existing plant and as per the certificate issued by Vasantdada Sugar Institute, Pune for 'No increase in pollution load' vide No. VSI/ST/5885/2011-12 dated-03.02.2012.
- 16. The capital investment of the Expansion & modernization of sugar unit is Rs.123.20 Cr. (Total Capital investment industry is RS. 194.74 Cr.)
- 17. Industry shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per EIA Notification, 2006 & amendment thereto.
