Under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000 and E-Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 2011 is considered and the consent is hereby granted subject to the following terms and conditions and as detailed in the schedule I, II, III & IV annexed to this order:

1. The consent is granted for a period upto 31/01/2015.
2. The actual capital investment of the industry for Part Consent to Operate is Rs.396.34 Crs. (As per Self Certificate)
3. The Consent to operate is valid for residential project of M/s. Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation EWS Project, Sector 17 and 19 (P) Chikhali, Pune, on Total Plot Area of 2,53,018.50 Sq. mtrs and Total Construction Builtup Area of 1,77,723.21 Sq. mtrs out of 3,25,633.84 Sq. mtrs.

Schedule-I

Terms & conditions for compliance of Water Pollution Control:

- 1) A] The generated sewage shall be treated in the Sewage Treatment Plant Provided by Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation at chikli. As per Tharav pass in PCMC General Body meeting No 18 held on 20/06/2013 in respect to the responsibility of treatment of sewage and shall achieve the following limits.

1	pH	Not to exceed	6.5 to 9.0
2	Suspended Solids	Not to exceed	100 mg/l.
3	BOD 3 Days 27 degree C	Not to exceed	100 mg/l.
4	Detergent	Not to exceed	101 mg/l.

- 2) The Board reserves its rights to review plans, specifications or other data relating to plant setup for the treatment of water, works for the purification thereof & the system for the disposal of sewage or trade effluent or in connection with the grant of any consent conditions. The Applicant shall obtain prior consent of the Board to take steps to establish the unit or establish any treatment and disposal system or and extension or addition thereto.
- 3) The firm shall ensure replacement of pollution control system or its parts after expiry of its expected life as defined by manufacturer so as to ensure the compliance of standards and safety of the operation thereof.
- 4) In case, the water consumption of the project is not covered under the water consumption of local body, in that situation, the project proponent shall submit the CESS Returns in the prescribed format given under the provision of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Cess Act, 1977 and Rules made thereunder for various category of water consumption.

In case the water consumption is duly assessed under the quantity of water consumption of local body, the project proponent shall submit certificate to that effect from the concern local body with the request not to assess CESS on their water consumption, being already assessed on the water consumption of local body.

Schedule-IV

General Conditions:

The following general conditions shall apply as per the type of the industry .

- 1) The applicant shall comply with the conditions stipulated in Environmental Clearance, granted by Environment Dept., Govt. Maharashtra, vide SEAC-2010/CR.731/TC.2 dt. 10/10/2011.
- 2) The applicant shall submit the affidavit in prescribed format regarding part of built up area under present consent being part of Environmental Clearance, within fifteen days from date of issue of this consent.
- 3) The generated sewage and MSW shall be treated in the Sewage Treatment Plant and MSW processing plant provided by Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation at Chikli. As per Tharav pass in PCMC General Body meeting No 18 held on 20/06/2013 in respect to the responsibility of treatment of sewage and MSW.
- 4) The applicant shall provide facility for collection of samples of sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
- 5) The firm shall strictly comply with the Water (P&CP) Act, 1974, Air (P&CP) Act, 1981 and Environmental Protection Act, 1986 and Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000 and E-Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 2011.
- 6) Drainage system shall be provided for collection of sewage effluents. Terminal manholes shall be provided at the end of the collection system with arrangement for measuring the flow. No sewage shall be admitted in the pipes/sewers down stream of the terminal manholes. No sewage shall find its way other than in designed and provided collection system.
- 7) The applicant shall install a separate meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of sewage treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.
- 8) Conditions for D.G. Set
 - a) Noise from the D.G. Set should be controlled by providing an acoustic enclosure or by treating the room acoustically.
 - b) The firm should provide acoustic enclosure for control of noise. The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. A suitable exhaust muffler with insertion loss of 25 dB (A) shall also be provided. The measurement of insertion loss will be done at different points at 0.5 meters from acoustic enclosure/room and then average.
 - c) The firm shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises in respect of noise to less than 55 dB(A) during day time and 45 dB(A) during the night time. Day time is reckoned between 6 a.m. to 10 p.m and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m to 6 a.m.
 - d) The firm should make efforts to bring down noise level due to DG set, outside industrial premises, within ambient noise requirements by proper siting and control measures.
 - e) Installation of DG Set must be strictly in compliance with recommendations of DG Set manufacturer.
 - f) A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use.
 - g) D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure.
 - h) The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.
 - i) The applicant shall comply with the notification of MoEF dated 17.05.2002 regarding noise limit for generator sets run with diesel.
- 9) Solid Waste - The applicant shall provide on site municipal solid waste processing system and shall comply with Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000 and E-Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 2011.

- 10) Affidavit undertaking in respect of no change in the status of consent conditions and compliance of the consent conditions the draft can be downloaded from the official web site of the MPCB.
- 11) The industry shall submit official e-mail address and any change will be duly informed to the MPCB.
- 12) The treated sewage shall be disinfected using suitable disinfection method
- 13) The firm shall submit to this office, the 30th day of September every year, the Environmental Statement Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form-V as per the provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) (Second Amendment) Rules, 1992.
- 14) The applicant shall make an application for renewal of the consent at least 60 days before the date of the expiry of the consent.
