With reference to above subject, this office has received your application for Consent to Operate under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization under Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 and Amendments thereto.

AND WHEREAS, it has been observed that you have carried out construction without obtaining consent to establish form Board & Commissioned the IT & ITES activity without obtaining consent to operate from Board and not submitted clarification regarding requirement of Environment clearance from Environment department Government of Maharashtra.

AND WHEREAS, the Consent Committee in the meeting dated 21/09/2013 has decided not to approve your Consent to operate application & also decided to issue refusal of consent for not submitting the required documents and satisfactory reply to the SCN issued by the board

THEREFORE, your application for grant of Consent to operate is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

You may prefer Appeal against the Refusal Order passed by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, in case aggrieved by the refusal order, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the Refusal order.
