Consent to Operate Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Authorization / Renewal of Authorization under Rule 5 of the Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundry Movement) Rules 2008

CONSENT is hereby granted to,

located in the area declared under the provisions of the Water Act, Air act and Authorization under the provisions of HW(M&H) Rules and amendments thereto subject to the provisions of the Act and the Rules and the Orders that may be made further and subject to the following terms and conditions:

# 14. The Consent to Operate (Part) is granted for a period up to: 30/11/2015

15. The Consent is valid for the part of operation of Textile Park project named as M/s. Asmeeta Infratech Limited, at 011, CFC 5, Asmeeta Textile Park, Plot No.1, Addl. Asmeeta Bhiwandi Industrial Area, Village Kon, Tal.-Bhiwandi, Dist.-Thane - Textile park with weaving units, spinning, garmenting units, wrapping, embroidery trading of textile products, Quality checking, fashion designing, training and ancillary services to support the park (without generation of industrial effluent and no air emissions) on total plot area of 2,42,814.00 Sq.mtrs, & total construction BUA of 47,902 Sq. mtrs out of 4,57,944.91 sq.meters including utilities as per construction commencement certificate issued by local body/ competent authority.

### **3. CONDITIONS UNDER WATER ACT:**

- (i) The daily quantity of sewage effluent from the factory shall not exceed 500.0 M3.
- (ii) Sewage Effluent Treatment: The applicant shall provide comprehensive treatment system as is warranted with reference to influent quality and operate and maintain the same continuously so as to achieve the quality of treated effluent to the following standards.

(iii) Sewage Effluent Disposal: The treated domestic effluent shall be 80% recycled and reused for flushing, fire fighting & cooling of Air conditioners and remaining shall be discharged to Municipal sewer. In no case, effluent shall find its way to any water body directly/indirectly at any time.

Project proponent shall operate STP for five years from the date of obtaining Occupation Certificate.

#### 4. Other Conditions: -

- All activities shall be in resonance with the provisions of Indian Forest Act, 1927 (16 of 1927), Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 (69 of 1980) and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 (53 of 1972), and special notification published for area wherever applicable and all the Environmental Statutes and Instruments.
- 2. Extraction of Groundwater for the project shall require prior permission of the State Ground Water Authority or other relevant authorities, as applicable;
- 3. Near the activities that are related to water (like activity of water parks, water sports) and/or in the vicinity of lake, Dissolved Oxygen shall not be less than 5 mg/liter.
- 4. In order to ensure that the water from this project do not enter into outside environment, the nallas crossing the township/complex premises, shall be lined, covered and made water tight by the applicant within the premises with intermittent inspection of chambers following good engineering practices as per the regulations of local body.
- 5. The Applicant shall draw plans for the segregation of solid wastes into biodegradable and non-biodegradable components. The biodegradable material shall be recycled through scientific in-house composting (i.e vermi-composting facility within premises) with the approval of local body. The proper demarked area shall be identified for collection & storage of MSW properly which, shall be finally disposed off at approved Municipal Solid Waste landfill site of local body environmentally acceptable location and

method. It is clarified that the term solid waste includes domestic, commercial, and garden wastes, but does not include hazardous and bio-medical wastes. The activities of bio-composting and engineered landfill shall be as per the Municipal Solid Waste (M&H) Rules, 2000.

- 6. Applicant shall be responsible to take adequate precautionary measures as detailed in this consent.
- 7. For disinfections of waste water ultra violet radiation shall be used in place of chlorination

- 2. Industry should provide acoustic enclosure for control of noise. The acoustic enclosure/ acoustic treatment of the room should be designed for minimum 25 dB (A) insertion loss or for meeting the ambient noise standards, whichever is on higher side. A suitable exhaust muffler with insertion loss of 25 dB (A) shall also be provided. The measurement of insertion loss will be done at different points at 0.5 meters from acoustic enclosure/room and then average.
- 3. The industry shall take adequate measures for control of noise levels from its own sources within the premises in respect of noise to less than 75 dB(A) during day time and 70 dB(A) during the night time. Day time is reckoned between 6 a.m. to 10 p.m and night time is reckoned between 10 p.m to 6 a.m.
- 4. Industry should make efforts to bring down noise level due to DG set, outside industrial premises, within ambient noise requirements by proper sitting and control measures.
- 5. Installation of DG Set must be strictly in compliance with recommendations of DG Set manufacturer.
- 6. A proper routine and preventive maintenance procedure for DG set should be set and followed in consultation with the DG manufacturer which would help to prevent noise levels of DG set from deteriorating with use.
- 7. D.G. Set shall be operated only in case of power failure.
- 8. The applicant should not cause any nuisance in the surrounding area due to operation of D.G. Set.
- (vi) Other Condition
  - a) The applicant shall provide ports in the chimney/(s) and facilities such as ladder, platform etc. for monitoring the air emissions and the same shall be open for inspection to/and for use of the Board's Staff. The chimney(s) vents attached to various sources of emission shall be designated by numbers such as S-1, S-2, etc. and these shall be painted/ displayed to facilitate identification.
  - b) Water spraying shall be done on ground to avoid fugitive emissions.
  - c) Construction material shall be carried in enclosed vehicles during construction activities.

# 7. CONDITIONS UNDER HAZARDOUS WASTE (MANAGEMENT, HANDLING & TRANSBOUNDRY MOVEMENT) RULES, 2008:

(i) The Industry shall handle hazardous wastes as specified below.

8. The applicant shall adopt environment friendly technology in development of the project.

9. This Board reserves the right to amend or add any conditions in this consent and the same shall be binding on the Applicant.

- 10. Applicant shall submit the affidavit within 15 days in the prescribed format regarding the part of the built up area/building for which application for Consent to 1st operate is made and that the same is included in the Environmental Clearance accorded.
- 11. The applicant shall submit <u>Bank Guarantee of Rs. 5.0 Lakhs</u> towards operation and maintenance of STP at Regional Office, MPCB, Kalyan within 15-<u>days.</u>
- 12. <u>Applicant shall allot plot only to the units such as, weaving , spinning,</u> garmenting, wrapping, Embroidery, trading of textile products, quality checking, fashion designing, training and ancillary service to support the park (Without generation of industrial effluent and no air emissions) and every individual unit shall obtain separate consent from the Board.
- 13. Applicant shall comply with conditions stipulated with Environmental clearance granted by the SEAC Environment Department Govt of Maharashtra vide no: SEAC 2010/CR.406/TC.2 dated: 28<sup>th</sup> September 2011.
- 14. This is issued pursuant to the decision of <u>Consent Committee</u> of the Board in its meeting held on <u>15<sup>th</sup> October 2013</u>.
- 15. The <u>Capital investment</u> of the Part project is <u>Rs. 72.53</u> Crores.
