- 6. The firm shall follow guidelines of storage of incinerable hazardous waste as per Hazardous Waste (MH&T) Rules, 2008.
- 7. The firm shall submit annual returns in form-4 as per Hazardous Waste (MH&T) Rules, 2008 to this office along with a copy to concerned RO / SRO office.
 - 8. The HW shall be transported through authorised HW transporter.
 - 9. The manifest system as per rule 21(1) in the Form No. 13 shall be implemented during transportation of HW as per the Rule.

- General Conditions:

- The authorisation shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection)
 Act, 1986 and the Rules made there under. The registration or its renewal shall
 be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the
 Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
- 2.. The person authorised shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the hazardous wastes without obtaining prior permission of the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board. Any unauthorized change in personnel or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of the authorisation.
- 3. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board to close down the facility. An application for the renewal of registration shall be made as laid down in rule of Hazardous Wastes (M,H &T) Rules, 2008.
- 4. Always store the hazardous waste under cover to prevent the leaching of any materials into storm water runoff.
- 5. The Hazardous material must be stored to prevent unauthorized people from accessing the area.

6. The Board reserves right to cancel / Amend/ Revoke the authorisation at any time as per the Policy of the Board / Government.
