Sub: Refusal of consent under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 and Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981.

Ref: 1. Your application for consent to 1st operate and amalgamation with existing consent on the bases of "No increase in pollution load" received through Sub-Regional Office MPCB Mahad.
2. Meeting of Consent Committee held on 12/12/2014.

This office is in receipt of your application for consent to 1st operate and amalgamation of existing consent on the bases of "No increase in pollution load" under Section 26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008.

Board office vide above referred letter no (1) has received your application for consent to 1st operate and amalgamation of existing consent on the bases of "No increase in pollution load" certificate submitted from Institute of Chemical Technology vide letter 30/9/2014. The case was placed before the consent committee of Board in its meeting held on 12/12/2014 and it was decided to refuse the consent to 1st operate (expansion) as there is clear increase in production quantity.

In view of this, your application for consent to 1st operate and amalgamation of existing consent on the bases of "No increase in pollution load" is refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as due to the proposed expansion there is clear increase in production quantity. If you feel so, you may go in appeal before Appellate Authority within one month's period & shall not take any effective steps towards expansion of production without Consent from Board and shall restrict the production quantity as per the existing consent.
