Whenever due to any accident or gas leakage or other unforeseen act or even, such emission occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith Reported to Collector, Directorate of industry, Safety and Health, Police Station, fire Brigade, Directorate of Health services, Department of Explosives, Board and local Body the production process should be stopped by taking all necessary safety measures. Industry shall also monitor the emission and ensure that the emission do not cause any harm or nuisance in the surrounding. The industry should not restart the process without permission of the Board and other statutory organization as require under the law.

#### 10. Industry shall comply with following additional conditions:

- The applicant shall maintain good housekeeping and take adequate measures for i. control of pollution from all sources so as not to cause nuisance to surrounding area / inhabitants.
- ii. The applicant shall bring minimum 33% of the available open land under green coverage/ tree plantation.
- iii. Solid waste The non hazardous solid waste arising in the factory premises. sweepings, etc., be disposed of scientifically so as not to cause any nuisance / pollution. The applicant shall take necessary permissions from civic authorities for disposal to dumping ground.

The applicant shall provide for an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed by the applicant to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. - vii. The applicant shall make an application for renewal of the consent at least 60 days before the date of the expiry of the consent.

- x. The applicant shall install a separate electric meter showing the consumption of energy for operation of domestic and industrial effluent treatment plants and air pollution control system. A register showing consumption of chemicals used for treatment shall be maintained.
