Your application for renewal of Consent to operate with increase in CI dtd. 30.01.2016.

3 Proposal submitted by RO, Nasik dated 18.03.2016 for initiating action against the industry.

4 Proposed direction issued by the Board vide letter no BO/CAC-Cell/RO(Nasik)/PD/TB-1906 dated 12.05.2016.

5 Decision taken by the Consent Appraisal Committee in its meeting held on 02.06.2016.

Board has granted consent to operate to your unit with certain terms and conditions which was valid upto 31.03.2016. WHEREAS NOW, you have applied for grant of renewal of existing consent to operate with increase in CI of your unit as per the provisions of Section 26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundry Movement) Rules, 2008.

AND WHEREAS, CAC-Cell has received the proposal from Regional Officer, Nasik to initiate legal action due to non compliance/violations of your unit and it was decided to issue proposed direction for 1) Why your manufacturing activity shall not be closed. 2) Why the competent authorities shall not be directed to disconnect your water & electricity supply for closing down manufacturing activity, 3) Why your consent shall not be refused due to following non-compliances & violation

 Domestic effluent generated from administrative building and SM4 plant was being discharged in the Nalla without any treatment.

- 2. Air pollution control system provided to fly ash feeding, cement feeding, cement silo etc sections seems to be inadequate thereby spreading of dust nearby area.
- 3. Water sprinkling, wetting and dust arresting system not provided at fly ash, cement storage, and feeding section thereby spreading the dust nearby area.
- 4. Huge quantity of asbestos waste mixed with non-asbestos waste stored in the premises along with fine dust waste.
- 5. You have not stored hazardous waste in scientific manner and stored in open condition.
- Your unit is establish at Gat. No. 152, 153, 153-A, & 177 of vill. Lakhmapur. Whereas
  previous consent is granted on Gat. No. 152 & 153, vill. Lakhmapur and now applied for
  renewal of consent at Gat no. 152, vill. Lakhmapur

AND WHEREAS, the proposed direction was issued vide reference No. (4). AND WHEREAS, you have not submitted any reply till today.

AND WHEREAS, your case was placed in the CAC meeting held on 02.06.2016 and it was decided to issue final refusal of renewal of consent to operate due to following non-compliance/violations

- Domestic effluent generated from administrative building and SM4 plant was being discharged in the Nalla without any treatment.
- 2. Air pollution control system provided to fly ash feeding, cement feeding, cement silo sections etc. seems to be inadequate thereby spreading of dust nearby area.
- 3. Water sprinkling, wetting and dust arresting system not provided at fly ash, cement storage and feeding section thereby spreading the dust nearby area.
- 4. Huge quantity of asbestos waste mixed with non-asbestos waste stored in the premises along with fine dust waste.
- 5. You have not stored hazardous waste in scientific manner and stored in open conditions.
- 6. The JVS results of Stack and AAQMS are exceeding the consented standards.

In view of above, your application for grant of renewal of consent to operate is hereby refused under Section 27 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundry Movement) Rules, 2008.

You may prefer Appeal against the refusal order passed by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, in case aggrieved by this order, to Appellate Authority within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the Refusal order.
