**Sub** - Refusal of Consent to Establish for expansion under section 27 of water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981.

WHEREAS Board has granted Consent to Operate to your existing unit vide above referred letter at sr. no. 1 with certain terms and conditions therein which is valid up to 31.07.2016.

AND WHEREAS you have applied for grant of Consent to Establish for expansion of 1500 TCD sugar unit, under the provisions of Section 25 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules 2008.

AND WHEREAS, your application for grant of Consent to Establish for expansion was placed before CAC meeting held on 09.03.2016 and during meeting it was decided to issue Show Cause Notice for refusal of Consent to Establish for expansion of 1750 TCD sugar unit due to following non-compliances / violations-

1. You have failed to provide 15 days storage tank to the existing sugar unit as per the CREP guidelines.

2. You have failed to install online monitoring system as per the directions of CPCB.
3. JVS results of the trade effluent collected on 16.01.2014, 21.02.2015 & 09.03.2015 are exceeding the Consented limits, also analysis results of stack monitoring carried out on 19.03.2014 & 17.11.2015 are exceeding the Consented limit.


AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of CAC, Show Cause Notice was issued vide dtd. 11.04.2016. AND WHEREAS, the reply submitted by you vide letter dtd. 03.06.2016 is not satisfactory.

AND WHEREAS, Sub-Regional Officer Sangli vide e-mail dtd. 14.07.2016 submitted verification report of SCN alongwith JVS reports of the samples of treated effluent collected on 15.12.2015 & 18.01.2016 and stack monitoring carried out on 27.11.2015 & 15.12.2015 out of which result of the sample collected on 27.11.2015 & 15.12.2015 are exceeding the Consented limit. Also reported that industry has failed to install online monitoring system.

AND WHEREAS your application was resubmitted before Consent Appraisal Committee meeting held on 10.10.2016 alongwith the reply submitted by you and compliance report submitted by the SRO, Latur, during meeting it was decided to issue final refusal of Consent to Establish for expansion due to above non-compliances/ violations.

In view of the above, your application for grant of Consent to Establish for expansion of 1750 TCD sugar unit is hereby refused under section 27 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 and under section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 and Hazardous & Other Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

You may prefer Appeal against the refusal order passed by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, in case aggrieved by this order, to Appellate Authority within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the Refused order.
