The Minutes of the meeting held on 26.11.2019, at 03.00 PM, MPCB, HQ, Sion-Mumbai under Chairmanship of Member Secretary, MPCB for Review implementation of Hon'ble NGT order in O.A.1038/2019 with regard to Comprehensive Environmental Pollution Index of Chandrapur, Maharashtra

Meeting of the stakeholders of CEPI area for **Chandrapur** was conducted under the Chairmanship Hon'ble Member Secretary of the MPC Board at Conference Hall, 4th Floor, MPC Board Head Office, Sion, Mumbai-22. List of participants who attended the meeting is attached herewith.

Dr. V. M. Motghare, Joint Director (APC) introduced the purpose of meeting. He gave presentation regarding directions of Hon'ble NGT & responsibility of stakeholders to comply with the same so as to bring down the CEPI of Chandrapur by way of abatement of pollution. He informed that in the Application No. 1038/2018, directions are given by Hon'ble NGT regarding CEPI score for **Chandrapur** as its rank is 27th in India as critically polluted area (Air Index is highest in India).


