Committee also noted that, fly ash utilization and legacy ash accumulation scenario is poor. PP has submitted long term and short-term plans. PP has submitted the issues regarding FGD installation, STP, compliance of Directions, EC and consent conditions. However, Environmental Compensation has not paid.
