Meeting was organized under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble District Collector, Chandrapur at Collector Office, Chandrapur on 12/08/2011. During the meeting, following members of CEPI committee were present:

Regional Officer, MPCB, Chandrapur has welcomed all the committee members and started the proceedings of meeting with the permission of Hon'ble Chairman. The Hon'ble Chairman has revived the action points in detailed and asked the respective stake holders about the progress made by them and given the directions during the meeting. Hon'ble Chairman has expressed his displeasure as other members of the committee have failed to attend the meeting & to submit the action taken report on the relevant points. The action points, present status and the proceeding of meeting are as under:


S No	Action Points	Responsible Stake Holders	Proceedings
1.	Provision of STP for Chandrapur Town. The domestic effluent generation from Chandrapur Town is about 30.0 MLD. Municipal Council has proposed to install two Nos. of STP having capacity 45.0 MLD & 25.0 MLD under UIDSSMT scheme, along with laying of sewerage line.	Municipal Council Chandrapur	Chief Officer, MC, Chandrapur has informed that construction work of STP at both the sites i.e. Pathanpura and Rahamat Nagar, Chandrapur is 70% completed. He further informed that the work of pipe line is 30 to 40% completed. This work is presently held up due to monsoon and expected to commence after monsoon. The Chairman has directed to speed up work of pipeline and further instructed Chief Officer to issue appropriate instruction to concerned agencies so as to complete the work before 31/03/2012.

2.	Use of treated industrial effluent for spraying for dust emission control in nearby mines and plantation in forest area, to reduce river discharge.	WCL, Forest department & Industry	The representative of Chief Conservator of forest informed that plantation work is carried out in rainy season and hence, no assured quantity of water is required for plantation. The Chairman has directed mining officer to explore the project for effective use of mine water for drinking water supply and irrigation, which is presently discharging into the Wardha river.
3	Provision of STP for Ballarpur town.	Ballarpur Municipal Council	Chief Officer shall attend the next meeting along with the compliance.
4	Provision of storm water drain in MIDC Tadali and MIDC Chandrapur	MIDC	The representative of MIDC shall attend the next meeting along with the compliance.
5	Development of alternative bypass road for transportation of the coal & other raw material transportation	WCL, Industries, PWD, RTO	The representative of PWD shall attend the next meeting along with the compliance.
6	Health Impact Studies: a) Health Impact studies due to air pollution problem can be undertaken in Chandrapur city by Health Department. b) Health studies in coal mine area can be undertaken by WCL authorities	Health Department WCL	DHO was not present during the meeting. However, CEO, ZP suggested to the Member Convener that Civil Surgeon, Chandrapur shall also be called for next meeting. The Chairman has directed to conduct Health related survey in CEPI area. Hon'ble Chairman has also appraised that one such study was conducted for certain area in the past by District Health Officer, Chandrapur.
7	Vehicular Pollution: a) Mass pool transportation system can be strengthened by State Government. b) Adulteration of fuel can be prevented by District Administration	Municipal Council / State Transport District Administration	The Chairman directed Chief Officer, Municipal Council, Chandrapur to identify the routes and agencies so as to have mass pool transportation system. The Chairman has stated that the regular monitoring is being carried out for checking adulteration of fuel and necessary action is being taken against defaulters.
8	Ballarpur: At present MSW of Ballarpur city (19 Ton/Day) is disposed in an	Municipal Council	Chief Officer shall attend the next meeting along with the compliance.

	unscientific manner. Municipal Council will have to develop waste treatment facility in a time bound manner for wet waste.	Ballarpur	
9	Chandrapur: Total MSW generation is 120 Ton/Day. At present 1.5 Ton/Day capacity of wet waste treatment facility is installed but not operational. Municipal Council is required to provide adequate capacity of waste treatment facility	Municipal Council Chandrapur	Chief Officer, Municipal Council, Chandrapur has informed that the site has been identified and at present only dumping is going on at the MSW site. The fencing work is completed. He further informed that the tenders are floated for installation of processing facility i.e. composting. He informed that the present wet waste treatment facility i.e. bio-gas generation facility was out of service and matter has been taken up with BARC, Mumbai for rectification of problem. The Chairman has directed to speed up the work of MSW project and expressed displeasure over unscientific disposal of municipal solid waste.
10	Shifting of Coal Depot located on Nagpur Road & Ghugus Road, Chandrapur.	District Administration	The Chairman has informed that the shifting of coal depot at a single cluster could be identified and necessary land can be allotted subject to NOC from MPCB. Regional Officer, MPCB, Chandrapur clarified that the NOC to coal depot could not be issued as these activities does not come under the purview of MPCB. The Chairman further directed that MPCB should issue necessary guidelines regarding coal depot for the control of dust emission in the vicinity.

With the permission of Hon'ble Chairman, Shri N. G. Nihul, Regional Officer, MPCB, Chandrapur has extended the vote of thanks and concluded the meeting.
