MINUTES OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEARING IN RESPECT OF PROPOSED **PROJECT FOR** PROPOSED EXPANSION OF TEMBHU LIFT IRRIGATION PROJECT, DISTRICT SATARA, SANGLI AND SOLAPUR, MAHARASHTRA (109 VILLAGES) PROPOSED BY PROJECT PROPONENT THE EXECUTIVE ENGINEER, MINOR IRRIGATION DIVISION, SANGLI WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT MAHARAHTRA KRISHNA VALLEY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (MKVDC), DISTRICT SANGLI- 416415, MAHARASHTRA. THE UPSA IRRIGATION SCHEME PROJECT PROPOSED TO PROVIDE THE BENEFIT OF IRRIGATION TO THE TOTAL 53 VILLAGES IN SANGLI DISTRICT SUCH AS 15 VILLAGES IN KHANAPUR TALUKA, 13 VILLAGES IN TASGAON TALUKA, 13 VILLAGES IN ATPADI TALUKA, 8 VILLAGES IN KAVTHE-MAHANKAL TALUKA AND 4 VILLAGES IN JAT TALUKA. DIST-SANGLI. MAHRASHTRA.

The Environmental Public Hearing in respect of proposed project for proposed expansion of Tembhu Lift Irrigation Project, District Satara, Sangli and Solapur, Maharashtra (109 villages) proposed by project proponent the Executive Engineer, Minor Irrigation Division, Sangli Water Resources Department Maharashtra Krishna Valley Development Corporation (MKVDC), District Sangli- 416 415, Maharashtra. the Upsa Irrigation Scheme Project proposed to provide the benefit of irrigation to the total 53 villages in Sangli District such as 15 villages in Khanapur Taluka, 13 villages in Tasgaon Taluka, 13 villages in Atpadi Taluka, 8 villages in Kavthe-Mahankal Taluka and 4 villages in Jat Taluka was conducted on Wednesday, the 21st Feb, 2024 at Auditorium, Vita Panchayat Samiti, Vita, Taluka Khanapur, District – Sangli, Maharashtra at 11.00 am.

As per the Office Order of The Member Secretary, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Mumbai has constituted Environment Public Hearing Committee vide Board's Office Order No. E-29 of 2023 under letter no. BO/JD (WPC)/PH/B-230426-FTS-022, dated 26-04-2023 and accordingly following were present for this public hearing.

Shri. Navnath S. Awatade, Sub Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Sangli, Convener of the Environment Public Hearing Committee welcomed Dr. Raja Dayanidhi, District Magistrate, Sangli and Chairman of the Environment Public Hearing Committee; Shri. Jagannath Salunkhe, Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Kolhapur and Member of the Environment Public Hearing Committee, Environmentalists, NGOs, Journalists, Representative of media channels and Company Officials and local people/participants who were present and with permission of The Hon'ble Chairman, Environment Public Hearing Committee started the proceedings.

Convener, Environment Public Hearing Committee informed that as per the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India, (i.e. MoEF & CC, GoI) dated 14th September, 2006 as amended on 1st

December, 2009, it is mandatory to conduct prior public consultation to certain projects which are covered in the schedule of the said Notification.

He informed that Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, was in receipt of application from Project Proponent Executive Engineer, Minor Irrigation Division, Sangli, Maharashtra to conduct Environment Public Hearing for their Proposed project for their Proposed Expansion of Tembhu Lift Irrigation Project, District – Satara, Sangli & Solapur, Maharashtra. The Upsa Irrigation Scheme Project proposed to provide the benefit of irrigation to the total 53 villages in Sangli District such as 15 villages in Khanapur Taluka, 13 villages in Tasgaon Taluka, 13 villages in Atpadi Taluka, 8 villages in Kavthe-Mahankal Taluka and 4 villages in Jat Taluka. Accordingly, as per Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi's Environmental Impact Assessment Notification 2006 and amended notification, as it falls under Category 1 (C), the said project is required to obtain "Environmental Clearance" and to conduct environmental public hearings in advance the today's hearing has been organized.

Convener informed that the aim of conducting prior public consultation is to make aware, local people who can be participant in the hearing and they should know the developmental activities and Environment Management Plan of the unit.

The Project Proponent submitted an online application dated 09 August 2023 for grant of preliminary approval (ToR) to the said project by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India, New Delhi and preparation of Environmental Impact Assessment

Report on 9th August 2023 and the application was approved online by the Government of India on 2nd November 2023 has been granted.

After approval of the Hon'ble Collector, Sangli to hold the said public hearing on Wednesday, 21st February 2024 at 11.00 PM, The Member Secretary, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Mumbai vide his office order no. E. 29 / 202, vide letter No.BO/JD/WPC/PH/B-23042-FTS 022 dated 26-04-2023 constituted Environment Public Hearing Committee.

As per the said notification, 30 days advance public notice was published by Sub Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Sangli in the Local Newspaper in "Daily Sakal" for Marathi language and in National Newspaper "The Times of India" for English language on 19th January, 2024. The public were appealed to send their suggestions, views, doubts or objections regarding the proposed unit. Also copy of EIA report and executive summery were made available in Marathi and in English at various notified Government offices as under -

Convener informed that, till date have not received any written suggestions/objections to the Sub Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Sangli regarding the said project. However, if the citizens present today have any objections or suggestions if any, they can give them in written or oral form.

Convener informed that an opportunity is given to all participants to raise any doubts, suggestions or objections regarding the proposed project in environmental angle, which can be submitted orally or in writing.

The Convener said that the suggestions / objections raised by you will be recorded in the minutes. Similarly, the revised environmental assessment report of the project promoters will be submitted to the Central Government through the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Mumbai for further action, taking note of the video recording, video footage, suggestions and objections raised in the meeting. After that the technical consultant of the project was requested to start the presentation.

With the permission of the Hon'ble Chairman, the project Environmental Consultant while presenting about the project and the Environmental Management Plan said that to provide the benefit of irrigation to the area of 41003 Hector from Vanchit 109 villages in Satara Sangli and Solapur districts, Water Resources Department, Government of Maharashtra on 30.09.2023, the 8 TMC water availability has been finally approved. Every year the people here are suffering from drought. The demand of people's representatives and farmers regarding providing water to these villages has been pending for many years. It is proposed to provide irrigation benefits to the area of 41003 Hector of 109 villages in 9 Talukas of Satara Sangli and Solapur Districts.

After the Presentation, Convener, Environment Public Hearing Committee appealed all participants to raise their suggestions, objections in respect of proposed project in environmental angle only. While asking questions, full name and residential address should be informed. This will be recorded as it is in the minutes of the said hearing.
