## Minutes of Environmental Public Hearing

M/s. Pernod Ricard India Pvt. Ltd. Located at Gat no. Gut No 110, 112, 126/1/A, 126/1/B, 126/1/D, 126/2/A, 126/2/B, 126/2/C, 127/1 to 127/5, 208/1, 208/2 & 365 at village Kadwa Mhalungi & Village Pade, Tal. Dindori, Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra proposed expansion of existing grain based distillery from 60 KLPD to 250 KLPD along with expansion of captive co-generation from 2 MW to 6.5MW

Public hearing for Environmental Clearance of Pernod Ricard India Pvt. Ltd. Located at Gut No 110, 112, 126/1/A, 126/1/B, 126/1/D, 126/2/A, 126/2/B, 126/2/C, 127/1 to 127/5, 208/1, 208/2 & 365 at village Kadwa Mhalungi & Village Pade, Tal. Dindori, Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra for their proposed expansion of existing grain based distillery from 60 KLPD to 250 KLPD along with expansion of captive cogeneration from 2 MW to 6.5MW was executed on July 03, 2024 at 12-00 noon. At the factory site under the chairmanship of Hon'able District Collector of Nashik.

As per the Office Order No. E - 140/2024 letter no. B.O. / J.D. (WPC) / Ph / B- 240613– FTS– 0122 Dt. On 13/06/2024 of Hon. Member Secretary, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Mumbai, Public Hearing Committee on Environment was formed and following officers of the committee attended the said public hearing.

Mr. Amar Durgule, Sub-Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board Nashik and Convener, of the Public Hearing Committee welcomed all the attendees at the beginning. Mr. Durgule briefed regarding the objective of the public hearing on environment clearance with the permission of the Hon. Collector. The

convenor gave information about the importance of the public hearing and the process followed.

Mr. Amar Durgule stated that as per the notification dated 14th September 2006 and its amendment done on 1st December 2009 issued by the Ministry of Forests and Environment, Government of India, New Delhi, it is mandatory to obtain environmental clearance for certain projects and before that public hearing is mandatory. Mr. Amar Durgule also said that an application has been received by M/s. Pernod Ricard India Pvt. Ltd. for holding a public hearing for their expansion of the existing grain based distillery from 60 KLPD to 250 KLPD along with expansion of captive co-generation from 2 MW to 6.5MW. In line with the application Hon. Collector Nashik directed to conduct the said hearing on 03.07.2024, Wednesday at 12.00 noon.

According to the above environmental notification, it is mandatory to give public notice about the public hearing in local newspaper 30 days prior to it. The Sub-Regional Office, MPCB Nashik had published a public notice regarding public hearing in local Marathi newspaper Marathi daily "Sakal" and English newspaper daily "Times of India" on 31.05.2024. Which appealed to the general public to register any objections, suggestions regarding the above project in written form.

Accordingly, the documents related to the proposed project i.e. English and Marathi copies of Environmental Impact Assessment report and Executive Summary Report were submitted at the notified offices of the Government i.e. Department of Climate Change, Government of Maharashtra, Environment and Administrative Building, Ministry, Mumbai, Headquarters, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Mumbai, Regional Office, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board -Nashik, Deputy Regional Office, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Nashik, Department of Environment and Climate Change, Government of Maharashtra, New Administrative Building, Ministry, Mumbai, Hon. Collector's Office-Nashik, Chief Executive Officer - Zilla Parishad, Nashik, Deputy Divisional Officer, Dindori, District-Nashik, Tehsil Office, Dindori, Gram Panchayat Office, Pade Village, Kadwa Mhalungi Village, Umrale Khurd, Nilvandi Pade, Valkhed, Ozarkhed, Awankhed, Karanjavan, Nigdol, Ta. Dindori, Dist. Nashik and was also made available for information and perusal for the general public on the website of the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.

Mr. Amar Durgule said if anyone from the attendees had any objections or suggestions, they can give it in written or oral form. The said suggestions/objections will be recorded in the minutes of the meeting. Similarly, the video recording of the said meeting will be submitted to the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change, New Delhi.

The public hearing for environmental Clearance was started with the permission of the Hon. Chairman.

The environmental consultant of the project explained on various aspects about the project such as - Environmental impact assessment, project details, project design, environmental status study, local environment details and area information, site information, air quality, noise intensity, Water quality of the study area. The presentation also mentioned regarding soil quality, bio-environment, socio-economic environment, expected effects on the surrounding environment, environmental management plan, remediation plan for various environmental effects, socio-economic welfare activities under the environmental responsibility plan, provision of environmental management costs, project benefits etc.

After that Hon. the Chairman asked the attendees to submit their comments, objections and suggestion in regards to the said project.

Though we extend our support to the expansion project, but you need to clarify on the utilization of the coal during crisis situation only.  2. - 4. The company has to strictly follow the green belt norms and should see that the plants are surviving and proper care has to be taken to maintain the same.
- 5. How C.S.R. fund is utilized needs proper monitoring? NGO is not utilizing the public fund appropriately is my concern.
- 6. In terms of environment, Rs.132 lakh will be nothing in it, 10-12 of our villages are there, and the amount should also be increased in this project. And we should work for our health by taking the sarpanch of the 10-12 gram panchayats in the local area and taking their members into confidence.
- 7. Due to our company, it is seen that the number of flies and mosquitoes has increased.
- 8. The well water samples of 100 farmers in the vicinity should be tested. The surrounding air should be checked and the report should be placed before this committee first and then tell that there is no pollution
- 9. It has come to our attention that this company's boiler chimneys are causing climate change and also disrupting rainfall.
- 10. Irrigation works should be done well.

be done in association with the local farmers and necessary measures would be adopted by the company to give confidence.

The existing green belt also is maintained and monitored and precautions as per your suggestions would be taken into consideration to maintain the green belt area.

The CSR fund mentioned of 132 lakhs is intended to be spent while the project is in progress. A separate budget is made for this and the said amount would be spent as per requirement and the advice of the authorities. As suggested by you the company will take the locals' into confidence to spend the fund appropriately.

The company would strictly follow the guidelines to maintain the balance.

2. Sharad Eknath Malsane at Lingdoh:-

The project proponent assured that we are taking note of what you said.

You are going to use 0.75 percent of the said project i.e. 132 lakh rupees for environmental or social work, and if buildings are given to the villages of Ekalgaon, Talegaon, it will definitely be good for the tribal students there.

We will definitely consider it as a priority with respect to the company's budget. The company's objective is to utilize the CSR fund to benefit of the people of our geographical area.

For water pollution control we have full fledge water treatment plant consisting of primary, secondary and tertiary treatment. The waste water will be evaporate and treated water used for secondary purposes and partly gardening in own land. There is no discharge outside.
