Modern Mineral Industry, Behind Milan Hall, Habib Nagar, Teka Naka, Nagpur-440017, Maharashtra has applied to Environment, Forest & Climate Change Department (MOEF&CC) Govt. of India, (GOI), New Delhi for permission of carrying out the study in the radius of 10 k.m. of project and preparation of Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Report for obtaining Environmental Clearance for the Proposed Project of Deolgaon Iron Ore Mine, At Deulgaon, Tal. Armori, Dist. Gadchiroli In Mine Lease Area Of 1.62 Hectare for Proposed Production Capacity of Iron Ore-3174 Ton/Annum Located At Deulgaon, Tal. Armori, Dist. Gadchiroli, Maharashtra.

The MOEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi approved Terms of Reference (TOR) was sanctioned on 24/11/2023. As per Environmental Impact Assessment Notification, 2006, the environment study should be carried in the radius of 10 km from the project site before environmental public hearing and to include in the final environmental impact assessment report. As the proposed project falls under Category B-1, it is mandatory to the Project Proponent to obtain prior Environment Clearance (EC) from SEIAA/SEAC, MOE&CC, Maharashtra.

Project Proponent M/s. Modern Mineral Industry, Behind Milan Hall, Habib Nagar, Teka Naka, Nagpur-440017, Maharashtra has applied to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board on 21/02/2024 for conducting Environmental Public Hearing. District Collector, Chandrapur, Maharashtra State, in co-ordination with MPCB Chandrapur Office, approved to hold a public hearing on 20/08/2024. In this connection, MPC Board decided to hold public hearing in respect of the said project on 20/08/2024 in consultation with District Collector, Chandrapur. Maharashtra Pollution Control Board has published public notices in Marathi newspaper namely "Lokmat" & and English newspaper "The Times of India" on dated 19/07/2024. The appeal was made to the concerned to submit objections, suggestions, complaints, comments, if any, in respect of the said project to concerned regulatory authorities. At the beginning of the meeting, Shri Umashankar Bhadule, Sub Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Chandrapur and Convener, Environment Public Hearing Committee welcomed Shri Sanjay Pawar, Additional District Magistrate, Gadchiroli and Chairman, Environment Public Hearing Committee; Shri Tanaji Yadav, Regional Officer, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, Chandrapur and Member, Environment Public Hearing Committee, Project officials, Journalists, NGOs working in the field of environment and local people who were present in large number and informed all the procedure of the public hearing. He appealed all the participants to raise views, doubts, ideas, suggestions or objections regarding the proposed project in environmental angle only. He said that the public hearing is organized for the local people and project affected persons, so that the environmental issues and doubts would be resolved.

Convener of the meeting further informed that this meeting is arranged to know the feelings, suggestions or objections of the local people for the proposed project in environmental angle only and this Committee has no right to sanction, reject or recommend the proposed project. The suggestions or objections received during the meeting will be noted and it will be included in the minutes of the meeting in Marathi and in English and it will be submitted alongwith Final EIA report, the written suggestions/objections with the approval of Chairman of the Environment Public Hearing Committee through MPCB Head Office to Environment, Forest & Climate Change Ministry, Govt. of India, New Delhi. An Expert Committee will take further decision accordingly.

Convener of the meeting further informed that as per the provisions of the Notification, the meeting is being photographed and video is being shot and after the presentation, the participants can raise their questions, suggestions, thoughts and objections. Objection/Suggestion/ Sr. Question No. Railway station Wadsa is the nearest 1 railway station to the said project but Railway station Talodhi which is located at 27 kms is shown as the nearest railway station in the EIA report. This is false information. 39 villages have been incorporated in the project as per 2011 census. It will be difficult to carry out study of these Health data has been villages. mentioned as nil but many men & women are affected from various diseases. For e.g. many people of Churmura village are suffering from Filariasis disease. Also the number of diseased people is very large. There is no drainage system in the said iron ore mining project. It will impact the environment on large extent & some nallas are flowing near the project which meets the nearby rivers. This will pollute the rivers & the polluted water will be provided to through taps in nearby villages. The transportation of iron ore will increase the pollution levels & it will adversely affect the health of local people. There is a confluence of 3 rivers near the village. These rivers get flooded in every monsoon & due to mining activity water pollution cannot be avoided which will affect the health of people. Ground water level will be depleted due to mining activity which will affect the nearby farmers. Agricultural fields are located near the project & due to transportation activities dust particles will get deposited on the fields which Due crop yield. will affect

Consultant Environment informed that, the said mine is located at Gat No. 40 & 40/2. Project Proponent will provide adequate air & water pollution control systems to avoid any kind of pollution. The said iron is small project ore compared to other mining projects. Due to financial crisis the said project was not in operation since last 10 years. If iron ore deposits are found then the project proponent will go for expansion of the said project. Water is available in huge quantity in the area. Mine water will be collected in the sedimentation tanks & after treatment, the same will be provided to farmers for irrigation purpose. Green belt will be developed through CSR & CER funds. Iron ore fines has high density due to which the iron ore fines are not dispersed in large areas & will not cause pollution in far areas.

Therefore, it is requested to provide employment to a minimum of 25 persons from each village which will help in reducing unemployment in the area. plantation shall be done to avoid pollution. Dust pollution will affect the households of Deulgaon Dongargaon villages which are located near to the project. Soil erosion will occur due commissioning of the said project. The forest & mountain area located near the project will get affected due to the said project. **Employment** opportunities shall be increased in the said project. Skilled employment to local people shall be provided to a greater extent to handle the matters of air pollution, water pollution, pollution & noise pollution. Proper compensation shall be provided to the project affected persons which are going to be affected due to the said iron ore project.
