Shrirampur due to cause acute water scarcity, in village Also, the ecological balance can be disturbed. Therefore, I have a strong objection to the said sand mining.

Environment Consultant Said that, Sand mining is necessary to prevent the risk of flooding in the River.

Chairman of Public Hearing Committee appealed to Participants raise any suggestions, objections and no any objections and suggestions obtained from the participants.

Chairman of Public Hearing Panel stated that the minutes of Public Hearing will be submitted to Environment Department, Govt. of Maharashtra and decision on Environmental Clearance will be taken by the authority accordingly.

The Public Hearing was ended with thanks to Chair.




