## Terms of reference of the committee are as under.

1. The Committee will give outline of suggestive / indicative strategy to prepare Action Plan for solid waste management, so that, directions accordingly can be issued to the Local Bodies.
2. The Committee will work out model requirement of the manpower, tools, equipment/infrastructure and financial requirement to ensure proper segregation, material recovery, storage, transportation, processing and disposal of waste.

3. The Committee will guide the ULB's and MPCB official on technical issues related to solid waste management.
4. The Committee will suggest the protocol for implementation of Solid Waste Management.
5. The Committee will interact with various stakeholders to evolve a consensus on the strategy/technological options for waste management.
6. The Committee may invite other Experts (As Invitee Members) for the purpose of executing the work, as and when required.
7. The Committee if required, will make site visits for assessment of issues.
8. The Committee shall meet at least once in month or as and when required.

**Tenure of Technical Committee:** The tenure of the said Committee is for two years from the date of issuance of this order.

**Reimbursement of TA/DA and siting fees:** The Chairman of the committee would be paid a sum of Rs. 7,000/- and the other non-official members of the Committee would be paid a sum of Rs.3, 500/- per meeting as an honorarium + Rs.1000/- travelling allowance (for local Members).

The Outstation Members would be paid First Class Rail Fare or Economy Air Fair or private vehicle reimbursement.
