## Circular

Sub: To obtain uniform Bank Guarantee towards compliance of Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 from Health Care Establishments (HCEs) and Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment facility (CBWTF) operator in State of Maharashtra

Ref: 1. Minutes of 184th Board meeting held on 10/03/2025

2. Board circular vide No. MPCB/PSO/BMW/B-1825 dated 10<sup>th</sup> April 2013

The Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, published on 28/03/2016, These rules shall apply to all persons who generate, collect, receive, store, transport, treat, dispose, or handle bio medical waste in any form including hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, dispensaries, veterinary institutions, animal houses, pathological laboratories, blood banks, ayush hospitals, clinical establishments, research or educational institutions, health camps, medical or surgical camps, vaccination camps, blood donation camps, first aid rooms of schools, forensic laboratories and research labs.

On 04/06/2012, the Central Pollution Control Board issued directions under Section 18 (1) (b) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, classifying industries into red, orange, and green categories, with Health Care Establishments (HCEs) requiring consent.

Health Care Establishments (HCEs) and Common Bio Medical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBWTFs) shall apply for combined consent and BMW authorization, submitting a Bank Guarantee to ensure compliance with bio-medical waste rules and other applicable environmental enactments. The Board published Uniform Guidelines on 10/04/2013 for obtaining Bank Guarantees from HCEs and CBWTF operators in Maharashtra.

Maharashtra Pollution Control Board in its 184th Board meeting, adopted a new Uniform Bank Guarantee structure:
