
CIRCULAR

Sub : Establishment/ Expansion of industrial units with effluent treatment in CETPs – regarding.

Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board has issued the directions u/s. 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 to MPC Board that establishment/ expansion of industrial units in areas where CETPs are not complying with the standards should not be permitted. The performance of CETPs at MIDC Mahad, Roha, Lote, Kurkumbh, Solapur is not satisfactory. Now, you are hereby requested not to allot the plots/ grant SSI registrations to any new Establishment/ Expansion in these MIDC area without permission of the Board to comply the above legal directions.

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

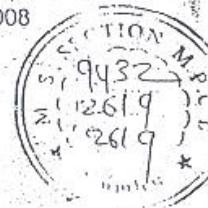

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Directions Under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974

WHEREAS, under Section 17 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) and Pollution Control Committees (PCCs), constituted under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 are to plan a comprehensive programme for the prevention, control or abatement of pollution of streams and wells in the state and to secure the execution thereof; and

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, one of the functions of the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), constituted under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 is to coordinate activities of the State Pollution Control Boards and Pollution Control Committees and to provide technical assistance & guidance to State Boards; and

WHEREAS, the Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETPs) have been set up in various States to treat combined effluents of cluster of industries that are significant sources of water pollution; and

WHEREAS, the Central Government has notified standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries and common effluent treatment plants (CETPs), under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, the SPCBs/PCCs can stipulate standards for discharge of environmental pollutants from various categories of industries and common effluent treatment plants (CETPs) more stringent than those notified by the Central Government, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and rules framed there under; and

WHEREAS, CPCB had been pursuing with your SPCB from time to time with regard to compliance of the CETPs with the prescribed standards for inlet and final effluent quality;

WHEREAS, CPCB had requested all the SPCBs/PCCs vide letter No. B-22013/2/PCI-III, dated May 18, 2007 to initiate monitoring programme for all CETPs at least once a month and to take follow up action against industries/CETPs not complying with the prescribed standards; and

WHEREAS, your SPCB has not informed CPCB of having initiated the regular monitoring programme for CETPs; and


WHEREAS, concerted efforts need to be made by your SPCB to stop direct discharge of untreated industrial effluents from industries/ industrial estates without connecting these to the CETPs wherever applicable; and

WHEREAS, CPCB had requested SPCBs/PCCs vide letter No. B-22013/2/PCI-III/2007, dated July 31 2007 that any expansion/establishment of the industrial units in areas where the CETPs are not complying with the standards should not be permitted without ascertaining the adequacy of the CETPs to comply with standards with respect to the additional discharge load on the CETPs, and

WHEREAS, your SPCB has not informed CPCB of expansion/establishment of the industrial units being not permitted in areas where the CETPs are not complying with the standards; and

NOW, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under section 18(1)(b) of the Water Prevention & Control of Pollution Act, 1974, the following directions are hereby issued to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board for compliance.

1. To initiate monitoring programme for all CETPs at least every quarter and take follow up action against industries/CETPs not complying with the prescribed standards; and
2. Not to permit expansion/establishment of the industrial units in the areas where the associated CETPs are not complying with the required standards and where such CETPs do not have adequate hydraulic load capacities; and
3. To submit action taken report every quarter on (1) and (2) above within one month of every quarter to CPCB

Sub: Directions under section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.

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With reference to above subject about directions u/s. 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 vide above ref. (2) that establishment/ expansion of industrial units in areas where CETPs are not complying with the standards should not be permitted. Therefore, Board has issued circular vide above ref. (3) to MIDC, Industries department, etc. and requested not to allot the plots/ grant SSI registrations to any new Establishment/ Expansion in MIDC Mahad, Roha, Lote, Kurkumbh, Solapur area without permission of the Board to comply the CPCB legal directions.

Now, Board has received representation from Chairman, CHEMEXCIL followed by letter from Prin. Secretary (Industries Department), Mantralaya, Mumbai vide above ref.(4) and Chamber of Small Scale Industry Associations through Development Commissioner (Industry) vide ref. (5) requesting MPCB not to stop the allotment/grant of permissions for Expansion / new Establishment of industrial units in MIDC areas as it will affect further growth of industrial area and the economy of the country. The representative from Mahad Manufacturing Association and Lote Manufacturing Association has also raised this point in Boards regular CETP review meeting convened by Member Secretary. The issue was discussed with Chairperson and technical HOD's of MPCB. It was decided to prepare the guidelines to permit Expansion / new Establishment of industrial units in such MIDC area so that pollution load at these CETPs will not increase and performance of CETP will not be

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affected and which will not violate the basic premise of the order of the CPCB. Accordingly, following guidelines are prepared which are approved by Chairperson of MPCB.

1. The industries which are ready to provide effluent treatment plant including tertiary treatment and recycle 100 % treated effluent in the process and propose to achieve zero discharge may be permitted.
2. The existing industries having Effluent Treatment Plant & complying consented standard may be permitted for expansion / diversification of product if there is "NO INCREASE IN POLLUTION LOAD" in respect of water and waste water aspect.
3. The industries which are generating concentrated incinerable effluent (high COD stream) & ready to send it to CHWTSDF for incineration may be permitted.
4. The industries which are not generating trade effluent may be permitted.
5. The permission may also be granted for new Establishment of industrial units to whom MIDC has given possession before issuance of CPCB directions u/s. 18(1)(b) of Water Act, 1974 dtd. 02/09/2008, with above mentioned conditions.
6. The industry shall ensure that the design characteristics of inlet effluent to CETP shall not change due to their production activity.

Secondly, I would like to bring to your notice that Ministry of Environment & Forest, GOI Delhi is also granting Environmental Clearance to industries to be located in above mentioned area.

In view above, we will ensure that load to CETP shall not increase and performance of these CETPs shall not be affected while allowing industries as per above guidelines without violating the basic premise of the order of the CPCB. In addition, various steps like increased/ periodical monitoring and vigilance of industries, upgradation of CETP, punitive measures like closures of violating units, etc. are being undertaken and which is being reflected in gradual improvement of the performance of these CETPs.
