Sub. :- Uniform guidelines for obtaining Bank Guarantees from CETPs

The CETP is one of the important Common Waste Management Facility for the cluster of the area in respect of proper collection, treatment & disposal of pre-treated, primary treated and fully treated effluent generated from the cluster of the area. The M.o.E.F., G.o.I. has laid down standards based on the category of industries (i.e. SSI/MSI/LSI) for disposal of pretreated, primary treated and fully treated effluent to CETP for inlet parameters for monitoring inlet parameters and outlet parameters, so as not to cause any pollution in surrounding area.

However, it has been observed that inspite of the rigorous monitoring of the MPCB, some of the CETPs are not being performing well due to not having proper control and supervision on the highly polluting industries in the said area. Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Mumbai is monitoring the performance of all the CETPs in the State of Maharashtra, more particularly six CETPs which have been made respondents in the PIL Bearing No. 17/2011. Therefore, the Board is in the process of strengthening its monitoring and also ensuring proper steps to be taken for functioning of CETP so as to achieve the standards laid down under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 by taking inplant measures, improving the operation and maintenance and wherever necessary to enhance the capacity / upgrade the CETP units in a time bound manner.


In order to ensure the compliance of the said improvement program and ensuring effective operation and maintenance of various conditions imposed on the CETP on the basis of the collection, treatment and disposal of their total effluent, the following guidelines are issued in respect of obtaining performance bank guarantees as well as bank guarantees for proper operation and maintenance of various conditions imposed after compliance of the performance Bank Guarantees as under :-

I) Bank Guarantees to be obtained for Operation and Maintenance of CETPs :-

Sr. No.	Capacity of CETP/s in MLD	Amount of Bank Guarantee
1	Upto 2 MLD	Rs. 2 Lakh
2	2 MLD to 10 MLD	Rs. 3 Lakh
3	More than 10 MLD	Rs. 5 Lakh

II) Bank Guarantees to be obtained for performance of CETPs (as per requirement) :-

Sr. No.	Particulars of Compliance and time frame for the same	Amount of Bank Guarantee
1	Provision of Website etc.	Rs. 2.50 Lakh
2	Treatability Study	Rs. 2.50 Lakh
3	Improvements in existing plants including sludge removal	Rs. 2.50 Lakh
4	Online pH meter, flow meter and TOC meter etc.	Rs. 2.50 Lakh
5	Tertiary or advance treatment facility	Rs. 2.50 Lakh
